LOS ANGELES, Cal., Oct. 20.—Doubt today still clouded the sudden death Saturday of Mrs. Craig Biddle, wealthy Philadelphia society woman, but police and district attorney's investigators admitted small evidence remained on which to build any theory involving foul play.

After a post-mortem examination yesterday Dr. A. F. Wagner, county autopsy surgeon, said death appeared to have been due to alcoholism. Mrs. Biddle's husband, internationally known sportsman, Craig Biddle, has maintained silence on the subject of her death.

**Want To Join With Union Church**

OTTAWA, Ont., Oct. 20.—Inspired by the fusion of Presbyterian, Methodist and Congregationalist churches of Canada, five religious denominations with branches all over the U. S. and Canada are negotiating with a view to forming a union of churches whose doctrine is founded on the teachings of John Wesley. This information was given out today by Rev. A. J. Shea, pastor of the local church of the Wesleyan Methodist connection. The churches which are named in this plan to reunite Wesleyan adherents are the Free Methodist Church of America with headquarters in Chicago; Wesleyan Methodist Congregation of America with headquarters in Syracuse, N. Y.; Pilgrim Holiness movement of Owen Sound, Ont.; Brethren of Christ, a branch of the Methodists of Western Canada and the United States and Nazarene Church with branches in Edmonton, Calgary and other western Canadian and United States cities.

The five denominations have a combined membership of several hundred thousands of members.

**IN MEMORIAM**

**MRS BRAMWELL BOOTH.**

TORONTO, Oct. 21.—Reflecting the spirit of the Salvation Army in its efforts to uplift the lower strata of society, Mrs. Bramwell Booth on Saturday morning, at Government House, presented an outline of her opinion on social conditions in conference with representatives of the press. Mrs. Booth who is the wife of the famous leader of the Army, General Bramwell Booth has come to Toronto to conduct the 43rd annual Territorial Congress, and is accompanied by her youngest daughter, Staff Captain Dora Booth.

Although disapproving the dole system and the indeterminate sentence for young offenders, Mrs. Booth stated very strongly that her condemnation of these two methods was in no way to be misconstrued as an assault on the Old Country, as one of the first principles of the Salvation Army was to be law-abiding and not to break the authorities by mere argument or controversy.

Speaking of the evil effects of the dole system she argued that some return should be expected. In view of the great shortage of domestic servants in the Old Country it was regrettable that 200,000 women were drawing the dole. Young boys leaving school, if they could not secure employment were also recipients of a dole. It would be better to require some work in return said Mrs. Booth, who suggested at least that they should be put through a few hours' drill each day. She related the instance of a lady requiring a chauffeur and offering 35 shillings a week with house and fuel to receive the curt reply that it was not worth while to work for 10 shillings a week, the dole received being 25 shillings.

In her office as magistrate, Mrs. Booth made a study of conditions among offenders against society and found the indeterminate sentence to be an unsatisfactory method of punishment. It was not wise to place first offenders under a cloud and to deprive them of their liberty. She would advise that punishment should be in keeping with the offence and should be short and sharp, and the opportunity provided at once for a fresh start. She strongly urged spending more money on preventive work rather than on all sorts of educational schemes after being committed to prison.

Her Notable Career.

Mrs. Booth first became interested in the Salvation Army in 1879. Then, as a young girl, having come to school from her home in South Wales, she read an article in a publication called "The Christian," telling of the Army's early days. She later joined the ranks of the Army and in 1882, she married General Bramwell Booth, son of the founder, General William Booth. On the inauguration of the Women's Social work, Mrs. Booth was placed in charge. Her mission of mercy has increased to such an extent that industrial institutions, homes for women and children, and hospitals have been added, until the work has become of great magnitude.

Mrs. Booth's visit to Toronto has been keenly anticipated by the women of Toronto, and although much of her time will be given to the Salvation Army Congress, she is also to address a meeting under the auspices of the Local Council of Women.
