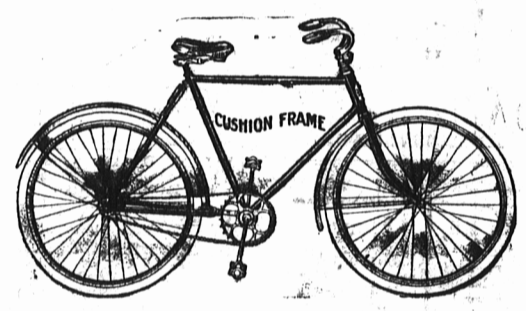

HOW TO TEST FLOUR.

When made into dough it will be elastic, easy to knead, staying in round, puffy shape with a springiness that is quite noticeable.
