MAKE \$800 MINIMUM WAGES IN POST OFFICE

WASHINGTON, Feb. 28.—That a man cannot live on \$720 a year and "keep up appearances" was the decision of the senate when it overruled its post office committee voted out all \$720 salaries for postal clerks and mail carriers and accepted \$800 minimum salary previously fixed by the house.

The senate adopted the \$800 salary by a vote of 31 to 17. Senator Ashurst produced figures during the debate to show that the average man in a responsible position could not maintain his family for less than \$788.54.

"That includes nothing for a book, a theatre ticket and excursion or anything that makes life worth living," he declared. "The average wage of American labor, Senator Cummings admitted, was not in excess of \$500 a year, but he said government employees must keep up a certain appearance, and the government should set the example of raising the minimum wage."



PATRICIAN "BOYS" WHITEWASH TRIBUNE "MEN"

credit of his team, Vernon's Patricians thus blanking Millview's Tribunes to the tune of 4-0.

JOHNSON BARRED OUT OF CANADA

BUFFALO, Feb. 27.—By the terms of a general order issued by the Canadian Government to the immigration inspectors at all border ports of the Dominion, Jack Johnson, the pugilist has been barred from admittance into Canada.

It is pointed out that this is likely to have the effect of barring the negro from landing anywhere on British soil. The action of the Dominion authorities is in response to public sentiment throughout Canada.

COUNSEL DECLINES TO PRODUCE PASTOR RUSSEL IN COURT

HAMILTON, Ont., Feb. 28.—Judge Snider yesterday made out an order for a commission to take the evidence of Pastor Charles T. Russel, of Brooklyn, who has instituted criminal libel proceedings against Rev. J. J. Ross, pastor of St. James Street Baptist Church. J. G. Farmer, representing Mr. Ross, and S. F. Washington, Pastor Russel, had a lively tilt before the order was granted.

Russel is in Central America and Mr. Washington positively refused to produce him because he said it was incumbent on the defence to prove that Mr. Ross did not publish the alleged libellous pamphlet.
