The Stanley arrived here yesterday. She had left Pictou Saturday morning and encountered a good deal of ice all the way up the straits but nothing to materially detain her until she arrived at the board ice at the outer roads off Summerside harbour. In this ice about 18 inches thick, resting on a bed of lolly and not brittle like mid-winter ice, she found a good deal of difficulty and at that suspended operations for the night. Yesterday morning she again started and forced her way through, arriving at Railroad Wharf about one o'clock. She had about 400 tons of coal on board and entered the harbour at a draught of 20 feet. This morning she will discharge her coal and freight, after which her future movements will be arranged for. Hundreds of citizens with teams and on foot lined her route from the edge of the board ice and gave vent to a hearty welcome when she arrived at her berth.
