THE MILITIA MAN AND THE REVIEW.

Complaints reach THE GUARDIAN on behalf of the militia men who were sent to Halifax to attend the Review. They were absent something over three days, during which time they were supposed to be paid 50 cents per day, with a further allowance of 25 cents per day for rations, and to have free transportation to and from Halifax. As a matter of fact no provision was made for feeding the men between Charlottetown and Halifax on the outward trip. Nor was there any opportunity given for them to purchase food.

While in Halifax, rather than take the Government rations, the officers, after consulting the men, made an arrangement with a caterer for 75 cents per day per man.

This, of course, consumed the entire pay and rations allowance of the men during their two days stay in Halifax. On the return they left their quarters in Halifax at 4 o'clock on Sunday afternoon and about dark started for Pictou, arriving there about 2.30 and reaching Charlottetown at 6 o'clock Monday morning. Thus from two two o'clock on Sunday, when they had dinner, till 6 o'clock Monday morning, a period of 16 hours, the men as a body had nothing to eat.

Some, at least, of the officers and men have conscientious objections to travelling on Sunday, but were forced to travel without any reasonable pretext on the part of the authorities. As it was, by travelling all of Sunday night the men arrived home hungry and worn out, and of necessity got something to eat and went to bed, thus losing the day. Had they remained in Halifax till Monday they would have been fed and rested, and would have been in good condition to go to work on Tuesday. It will be seen that not much regard was paid by the authorities either to the day of rest or to the demands of hunger on the part of the men.

During two years past the astronomers have predicted remarkable meteoric displays in November, but in both years the shower of meteors failed to appear at the time appointed. Mr. F. McBennett writes to the Scientific American that a great display may be expected about the 15th November next. He says the ascertained period of the most brilliant displays of meteors in years past is 34 years and 1 day. Thus, the first recorded shower was witnessed on the night of November 12-13, 1799; the next on that of November 12-13, 1833; the following one occurring on November 13-14, 1867; so that the next becomes due on the night of November 14-15, 1901—in a few weeks hence.
