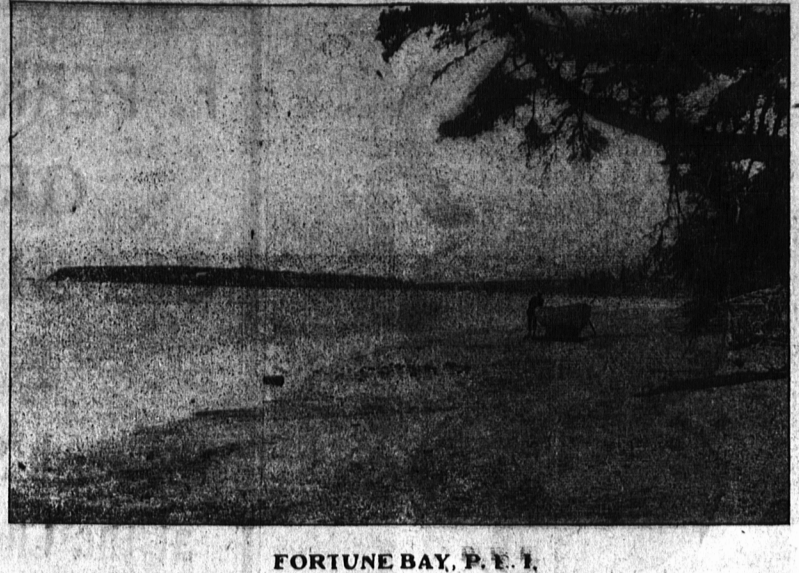

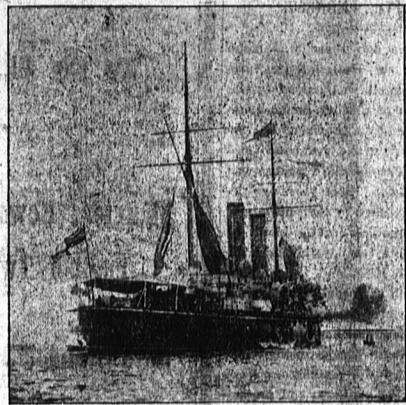

KING'S SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING.

SYDNEY, July 22.—The local committee of the King's School of Engineering met on Monday to finally consider the various sites for the proposed college which have been under discussion for some weeks. It was agreed to purchase a section of the Sherwood property near the tennis grounds, located between South Bentinck and Shandwick streets and the brook, and comprising about four acres. The price paid is said to have been about \$4,000, the owners of the property contributing \$1,000 to the college building fund. It is generally agreed that the property selected is an ideal one for the college, and cannot be surpassed for that purpose in the province. Plans and specifications are being prepared and tenders will shortly be called for.

HALED TO COURT.

Boston, July 21.—In court at Quincy, yesterday, Henry M. Whitney, of Boston, president of the Chamber of Commerce, was arraigned for running an automobile at Quincy beyond the legal speed limit.
