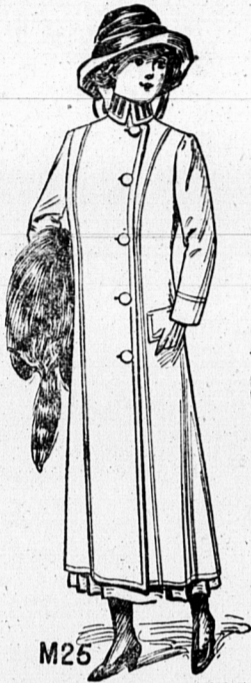

PASTOR SAYS GIRLS MUST BE GOOD COOKS

Iowa Minister Conducts Domestic Science Class for Young Women Parishioners as Part of His Duty

LOGAN, Iowa, Sept. 17—"Feed your husband on apple pie and he won't want to drink whiskey." That is the new system worked by the Rev. C. S. Lyles, pastor of the Methodist church of Logan, and in addition to preaching his regular sermon the Rev. Mr. Lyles is seeing to it that every girl connected with his church and Sunday school is being taught to cook—and to make pies.

The Rev. doctor does not confine his new "cure" to apple alone, but says that drunkenness, in a large measure, can be attributed to the want of nutritious and properly prepared foods. And so, instead of starting a crusade against saloons, Dr. Lyles is making an onslaught on poor cooking as the best means of preventing or lessening drinking. So earnest is he and so enthusiastic that he has succeeded in impressing his ideas upon his entire church, and the big cooking school of the Methodists of Logan is attracting attention all over western Iowa.

"Most of the drunkenness is caused by poor cooking," says Dr. Lyles. "The body requires a number of elements to keep it growing and these elements must be taken through the stomach. When food does not contain the necessary elements there is a craving for them just the same."

"One of these elements is alcohol, and for natural purposes a certain amount of this stimulant is necessary. But this alcohol must be formed in the stomach, not taken in all ready made."

"From some foods this alcohol cannot be made, and as a result of being on them there is a lack of alcohol formed and the body demands a stimulant from the outside. Likewise, when food is so poorly prepared that the nutrition cannot be formed within the stomach, the system cries aloud that it be supplied from some other source."

"When cooks do not know the elements needed the wrong food may be taken. For instance, some time ago I watched a number of workmen eating lunch. One man had a vinegar pie—and nothing more. Another had a hunk of bologna—and nothing more. These two men had worked hard all forenoon and were expected to do the same thing in the afternoon. These men needed different foods and I was not surprised to know that they secured it in liquor form."

girl lunching on a sandwich and a pickle. Another girl was lunching on olives and chocolate ice cream. A school boy was eating a sandwich fairly covered with mustard. These children were not being properly nourished.

"And when the body is not properly nourished it begins to ask for the needed things. Too often these cravings are satisfied with strong drink. And this leads to the fixed habit of satisfying the natural cravings of appetite for the required elements of body building with drink. And the rest of the road to drunkenness is easy."

"If all that is true don't you see how necessary and important good cooking is? The woman who fills her husband's dinner pail with the food that contains all the elements required to replace worn out tissue, will use the largest possible protective and more surely keep that husband from drink."

"With this idea in view, Dr. Lyles is systematically going about the training of the girls of his Sunday school into good cooks. The mothers of the church girls are, to a large extent the teachers, although the Rev. Dr. Lyles holds a supervising hand on the broad foundations of the work. Business men of the city have interested themselves in the plans of the preacher, and all sorts of inducements are held out the girls, that they may become good cooks."

"Almost every week there is a cooking contest, the products, baked entirely by the girls, being placed in the hands of a committee of judges who pass upon the quality of the cooking and present certificates of honor to the winners. To every contestant is then paid a sum of money sufficiently large to cover the cost of materials used, in order that all may feel free to enter the contest."

Last week, at the close of an apple pie baking contest, the winning pie was sold for \$1.

But the minister's efforts are not confined altogether to the girls of the parish. He has worked up a large organization among the things they should ask in the way of foods in order that the cravings of their appetites made not lead them towards alcohol and other stimulants. While the boys are not taught to cook they receive instruction in what a satisfying

dinner should consist of. The woman who is thoughtless and careless about her husband's meals, who gives him sour things instead of sweets, who uses pickles and other foods saturated with vinegar instead of wholesome sweets, is inviting her husband to use stronger things than she puts into his dinner pail.

For these reasons it will pay the church big dividends to look well to the encouragement of the domestic side of life, and especially to the proper selection and cooking of the different meals of every day living.

And don't forget the apple pie. The boys' organization of the Methodist church of Logan, under personal supervision of the Rev. C. S. Lyles, has attended lectures on cultivation of fruit from the time the seed is planted until the fruit is ready for the home market. The pastor has given lectures on the cultivation of corn from the time the ground was prepared to planting the seed and harvesting the crops, illustrating his lectures by a great number of lantern slides which he has collected.

Recently the boys completed some work and are now able to tie all the different kinds of knots and make different kinds of hitches. The boys have also taken up the study of small grains and the most successful methods of production on the farm.

The scouts have completed for themselves the flashlight, or heliograph, by which they expect to establish communication with persons at a distance.
