**DELAGOA BAY.**

The South African Republic, commonly spoken of as the Transvaal, is surrounded by British territories except on its eastern side where a strip of country belonging to Portugal is interposed between the Transvaal territory and the sea. At the southern and narrowest part of the Portuguese possession is an indentation of the coast-line known as Delagoa Bay. From this point a railway extends inland tapping the Transvaal and furnishing it with an outlet. Were this bay in possession of any other great power than Britain it would seriously menace British interests. When the German Kaiser, a year ago, threatened to take up the Boer's quarrel with Britain, the importance of the control of Delagoa Bay was readily seen.

Since that time there have been negotiations with Portugal in regard to the matter but nothing could be arranged, owing to the opposition of Germany. More recently, as announced by Mr. Chamberlain, Britain and Germany came to an amicable understanding with regard to their African affairs, and now the statement is made that Delagoa Bay has become British, no doubt by purchase. Now if Kruger wants to make trouble with Britain he will find his possessions surrounded and Britain in possession of all his outlets.

A feature of the New Brunswick campaign is that a number of government supporters in the late house are now running in opposition to the government. Among these are Dibblee, in Carleton county, Fowler in Kings, Chipman in Charlotte and Summer in Westmoreland, all Conservatives. The Moncton convention of last autumn seems to have been effective so far in securing the withdrawal of a portion of the Conservative support. This, however, has the effect of making the Liberal element more united in support of the government, while other Conservatives appear to have taken the places of the seceders on the government tickets.

We mentioned the other day a new invention to do away with type-setting. A much more wonderful invention, or discovery along the same line is noted in the New York Sun. According to that journal a Frenchman has succeeded in printing, photographically by means of the X rays. The inventor reasoned that if the X rays would penetrate an oak log they would do the same with a pile of paper. He claims that he can now print 1000 sheets at once, reproducing articles or illustrations, but subject to the disadvantage that both sides of the sheet will bear the same impression. He can print in black letters on a white sheet or white letters on a black sheet. The secret is an ink that is impervious to the X rays, used on a prepared or sensitized paper.

Pianists require great suppleness of the hand and dexterity of the fingers. Dr. Forbes of Philadelphia is now performing a simple surgical operation which, it is claimed greatly increases the independence of movement of the several fingers of the hand. The tendons that move the fingers are tied together by cross tendons in the back of the hand. By reason of this the closing or extension of one finger in some measure, more or less in different persons, also moves the next finger to the one intended to be moved. By cutting the cross tendons in the back of the hand each finger is left perfectly free. It is claimed that Dr. Forbes has performed this operation many times, and with surprising results in the case of piano players.

Bystander, (Dr. Goldwin Smith) has this to say of the Doukhobors: "Most of us would prefer British immigrants to Doukhobors. Still the Doukhobors are welcome. Exiles for conscience sake, they are sure to be religious, pretty sure to be moral and industrious. Their religious kinsmen, the Mennonites, have made excellent farmers, though as citizens they are said to leave something to be desired. But there is no occasion for reviling Russia. Military service is the law of that empire, as it is of Germany, France, and other European countries; and people either must conform to the law of the country in which they live or go elsewhere. Even in Canada, the Doukhobors, as soon as they are naturalized, will by law be included in the enrolled, though not in the embodied militia.

A Boston subscriber sends a copy of the Post of that city containing an account of the costly funeral of a pet monkey. The pet, Peppo by name, was owned by a Mrs. Guild and fell a victim to the grip. The Post tells that his funeral was rich and impressive. He was embalmed by a regular undertaker. His body was laid out in a robe of quilted white satin. His casket was covered with blue velvet and lined with fine white satin. A silver plate on the lid bore the simple inscription "Peppo." There were floral offerings from friends. And such friends for a monkey! They came in private carriages from all parts of Boston's swell Back Bay to view his remains. Then there was a cortege to the railway station, and out at Sharon, near his own summer cottage among the pines, Peppo was interred. Our correspondent strongly condemns all this expensive flummery over a dead animal, especially in a city where there are hundreds of innocent homeless children, suffering from hunger and cold.

The Australian federation scheme provides for the union of all the cluster of colonies but Queensland, which sent no delegates to the recent conference. All the colonies will be given equal representation in the Senate, which will be an elective body. In case of a disagreement between the two houses a conference plan is provided whereby the two houses will vote together and the vote of the majority will decide the issue. This is the plan proposed by Sir Wilfrid Laurier for Senate reform in Canada. A High Court of Appeal is provided for, similar to the Supreme Court of Canada, but its decision will be final in deciding issues between provinces. In private litigation there may be an appeal to the Privy Council of the Empire.

**The Manly Boy.**

Writing about boys in the February Canadian Magazine, the Editor says: "Above all things, a boy must be taught to be manly. In England this is taught mainly through the sports in which the youth are trained either by intelligent masters at the great boarding schools, or under the immediate supervision of sympathetic parents. It is also taught at home. In America it is not taught to as great an extent in our public schools, because the children's play is under a much looser supervision hence it must be taught more at home."

What does manliness mean? It means a dignity which makes the young man respect his own rights and those of others. It includes a moderation in speech, a temperance in action, a magnanimity in conduct towards others; and an earnest loyalty to duty. It has no limits, no defined bounds. It is a garment which envelopes and surrounds the man, so that he may always be distinguished from the cad, the sneak, the drone, the criminal. It is the mainspring of all generous acts, of all progress, of all wisdom. It is the first and most necessary equipment of the man who would write his name in silver letters on the golden page of history. It is the concentrated essence of all virtues without a trace of impurity. It is the halo which makes the man a god."

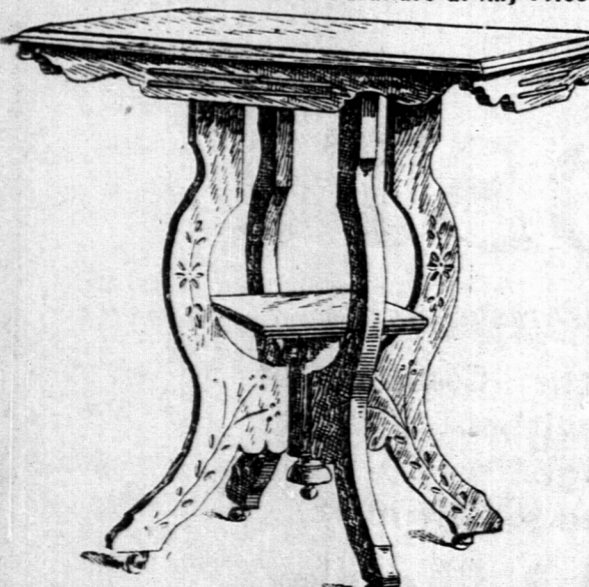

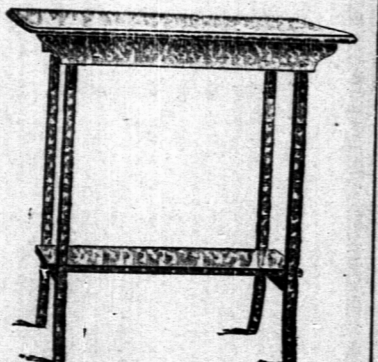
