Britons Shiver; Told Must Conserve Fuel

LONDON, Oct. 1.—(AP)—Britons shivered in the first cold snap of autumn today but the Ministry of Fuel and Power warned that the summer-time ban on heating of non-residential premises with gas and electricity will remain in effect until Oct. 31 unless weather conditions make an early relaxation necessary.
