**W J BRYAN IS AN IMPOSSIBLE**

Will Never Be President, Says The New York Times

New York, Sept. 10.—The line which the less radical Democratic newspapers have taken in regard to Bryan is exemplified by a long editorial in the Times, which formally repudiates him.

Following are extracts:

"Mr. Bryan will never be president of the United States. It is very doubtful if he is growing every day more doubtful whether he will be nominated by the Democrats in 1908. If he gets any nomination at all it is more likely to come from some rump of radicalism than from the old organization. He is about the most disuniting leader the party ever had. He has a veritable genius for discord, division, faction, dispersion and defeat.

"He was of the silver potters in 1896, but in 1900, he had developed the dominating spirit and he dominated the St. Louis convention, forcing the fatal doctrine of free silver into the platform against the protest of the party. Again in 1904 he beheaded the convention at St. Louis to such good purpose that, although personally he is supposed to have given Judge Parker loyal support his followers in great numbers went over to the enemy.

"Before his recent return from Europe the Democratic party seemed to be getting itself into condition again. He put a stop to all that. His public ownership speech was like a bomb exploded in the vitals of the democracy. It rent and mangled it and the disaffected members and fragments have not even yet all fallen to the ground.

"Mr. Bryan is an exceedingly attractive speaker, but he is absolutely deficient in the qualities of statesmanship. And it is his position as the nominal leader of the Democratic party and as a continual candidate for the presidency that makes his writings and lectures merchantable. They are quite destitute of intrinsic value. He does not enlighten. At his very best he is capable only of pointing out the obvious thing, the superficial thing, the thing everybody has seen and knows. Besides that, Mr. Bryan sees and knows a multitude of things that are, not so they are not as he sees them, not as he thinks he knows them. Nobody would wish to diminish Mr. Bryan's capacity for earning a living, but there is no visible reason why the Democratic party should condemn itself to everlasting defeat and death merely to furnish an income to this ambitious and incapable Nebraskan. The party has a fine opportunity to rid itself of him."

**KINGS HORSES MAY BE BOUGHT**

(Toronto News.)

Will the King's horses stay in Canada? It is only a matter of price and it may be that it can be satisfactorily arranged. Several horse breeders would like to have them, and it is known that W. E. Wellington offered a pretty figure for a horse and a filly, and negotiations are not completely "off" yet. United States breeders, too, are anxious to get them. Bratton of St. Louis offered \$10,000 for the lot and a Chicago firm made an even better offer, but both were turned down.

Mr. Beck, who in charge of the horses, is quoted as saying that he would like to leave the horses in Canada. They are to be exhibited at the London and Ottawa exhibitions and will then be taken to the "Royal Stock Show" at Kansas City, Chicago wanted them for the annual fat stock show in December, but it was declared to be impossible to keep them here until that time.

"While the horses are good and I would like very much to have them, there is no inducement in Canada to pay a high price," said Mr. Wellington, when queried by a World man. "They can't be made to pay, but it is especially so of the Shire breed which are not in such demand as Clydesdales. Mr. Beck is not asking an excessive price, for they are really an expensive breed, and in the old country are held mainly by rich men, with whom it is a sort of hobby."

He mentioned that five years ago his firm had invested \$2500 for one that last spring brought only \$625. One, purchased in England at "a pretty price," will soon be on the way over.
