Former Island Preacher Outlines Wartime Program

The following report appeared in a recent issue of the New York Times:

A six-point program "as a means for keeping steadfast and resolute in wartime" was offered to members of his congregation in his sermon yesterday morning by the Rev. Dr. John Sutherland Bonnell, pastor of the Fifth Avenue Presbyterian Church at Fifty-fifth Street. After suggesting that "national morale depends finally on each one of us," Dr. Bonnell made the following suggestions: 1. Carefully observe the rules of health so that you may keep mentally and physically alert. Keeping well is a patriotic duty in wartime, for every sick person is a liability and a drag on the national effort. Avoid over-fatigue and emotional tension. Observe periods of occasional rest. 2. Engage in constructive work of definite assistance to the national effort. It is dangerous to one's mental peace to be an idler. Do not give up important peacetime work for the glamour of a war job. The work of our social agencies must be continued. 3. Commit yourself and your loved ones to God's keeping and trust Him for the outcome. Worry in these matters is far more destructive than overwork. 4. Do not listen to or spread unfounded rumors. One of the most stubborn problems of the British authorities has been the occasional spread of the spirit of defeatism, which originates in one community and spreads throughout the nation. That is a service rendered for the enemy. 5. Avoid activities and people that tend to produce emotional insecurity and "war jitters." Avoid overmuch listening to war bulletins on the radio or reading them in the newspapers. Associate with people who have confidence and resolution. Refuse to join in destructive criticism of national leaders for this is evidence of poor morale. 6. Set apart at least ten minutes in the day for waiting upon God and drawing upon His resources of serenity and peace. Base this period of retirement and meditation on Scripture passages such as the 57th or the 46th Psalm.

Eloquent Appeal By Dr. McMillan For Victory

The following appeal on behalf of the Victory Loan was recently delivered by Hon. Dr. W. J. F. McMillan:

"If I expressed my most sincere wish at this moment, it would be for the dramatic eloquence of the illustrious Churchill, or his great team mate Roosevelt so that I could adequately impress my listeners with the true importance and inevitable results of this 3rd Canadian Victory Loan appeal so far as the fate of Canada, and the Empire is concerned. May more of its vital effect in this supreme struggle where the world, where Democratic institutions, where civilization, where religious freedom, where all that is dear to Christian God loving people may be lost by our lack of supreme sacrifice. Our military leaders know too well, and civilians also should know the real aim and object inspired by the Demons of hate, and selfishness in the twisted minds of our ruthless and deadly foes led by that super arch demon, ruined by the insane delusions, the vile in Germany revealed in base inhuman plan in all its sordid grisly detail. Coupled with world domination is the pre determined scheme of destroying the British people completely. How or in what manner? For your own sakes, for the sake of our great Empire, for the sake of civilization, for the sake of Christianity, listen, and heed and act. Now I give you the devilish plan. 1st. The death of all old men and women before the firing squad. 2nd. The condemnation of young women and girls to worse than death—a life of shame. 3rd. The condemnation of the younger men to a life of drudgery, and toil as Enoch slaves. The skeptic says, 'They wouldn't do that they can't do it.' I say, wouldn't they, can't they. Let Poland answer, let the small peaceful liberty loving people of down trodden Europe give their sorrowful answer. Yes, for God knows they are paying the price. The price has been put on the life of every one British descent. What are you going to do about it? What can you do about it? Let me tell you.

"The loyal Canadian men who are sponsoring this appeal, and are endeavoring to make this Victory Loan the success it must be, if we want to exist, are not asking any favors from our people. They are pointing out a plain patriotic Christian duty. 'What sacrifice are we making in lending money to the Government at the best rate of interest now available. — 1-2 per cent in the Dominion Savings Bank or 3 per cent in Dominion War Bonds. They should get a billion dollars because they need nearly twice that much this year. Prince Edward Island is asked to lend \$3.4 millions. Prince Edward Island shouldering 2 1/2 million of \$600,000,000 was responded to lions. The last great Victory Loan by the Canadian people with \$834,000,000. Let us do our duty in the same proportion, and this loan will reach the billion dollar mark. 'We cannot realize the terrific cost of a mechanized war, but let this give you an idea.
