WHAT GERMAN PHYSICIANS ARE TEACHING GERMAN MOTHERS ABOUT ALCOHOL

While a small group of French physicians have been induced by the wine interests to enroll under the name of "Medical Friends of Wine" and—contrary to the declaration of the French Academy of Medicine—are lauding wine as a hygienic drink, leading German physicians are taking the opposite course. Instead of lending their professional names to promote the profits of wine-growers they are using their prestige to promote the growing of healthy children.

If the contrasting advice of these two classes of physicians is widely followed in their respective countries, the result on the destiny of the two nations is easily predictable.

The advice of the German physicians covers two important periods in child culture, that is, prenatal life and childhood. Inasmuch as the brewers in this country are planning to persuade American mothers that beer-drinking will benefit their own health and that of their children, the opposite advice of highly qualified German physicians in the home-land of beer, ought to be worth considering.

Here are some of their statements:

"According to present scientific knowledge we must assume that alcohol is a germ poison. Not only does it injure therefore, those who drink, but it weakens their descendants physically and mentally. For that reason young people, keep away from alcoholic drinks. Guard your young women against them, that the parents of your children may be free from alcohol."

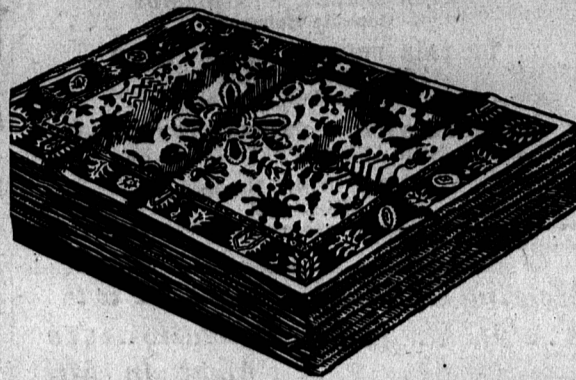
—Dr. Phlaethes Kuhn, Professor of Hygiene, Dresden. "Alcohol is an enemy to the development of life. Whoever is convinced of that knows how fatal the use of alcohol can be to the most important of the vital organs and to the development and maintenance of new, young life. It cannot be sufficiently emphasized that the expectant and nursing mother should live entirely free from alcohol. For us Germans, day and night for our coming generations there are no more important words than those of our great philosopher,—"There is no higher religion than reverence for life!"

—Dr. Rauss, Counsellor of the Board of Education, Bielefeld, Germany. "The use of alcohol by the young must be forbidden, under all circumstances. That holds true not only for hard liquors, but also for the lightest beers."

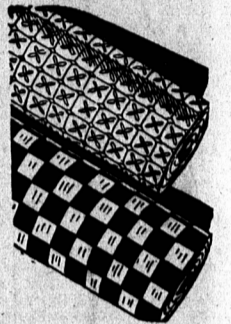

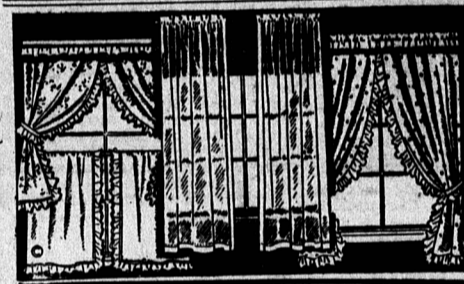
