Contract Bridge

A Matter of Tactics

Many players seem to have the idea that if an opponent passes once or twice and then enters the auction at a higher level, he is showing weakness, and is merely doing some "wild defending." In the case of experts, the actual fact is quite to the contrary. Observe the tactics of the South player in today's deal.

Best dealer. Both sides vulnerable.

♠ 8 3
♥ Q J 9 5
♦ K 10 7 3
♣ 8 5 2

♠ Q 7 4
♥ K 8 3
♦ A J 6 2
♣ 10 9 7

♠ 5
♥ A 10 7 6
♦ 9 4

The bidding:

1♥ South West North
2♥ Pass (1) NT Pass
3♥ Pass 3♦ Pass
Pass Pass

could have been nearly as successful as South's actual tactic in passing and then reentering the auction at a higher level.

South, an expert, knew that it was almost inconceivable in view of his own distribution, that the one-heart bid would be passed all round, and since he had the ranking suit, spades, it was equally conceivable that he could be shut out. His pass, then was pointed at two objectives: to gauge West's strength from his response to one heart, and to make the opponents feel, when South did finally come in, that he was merely "taking a flyer."

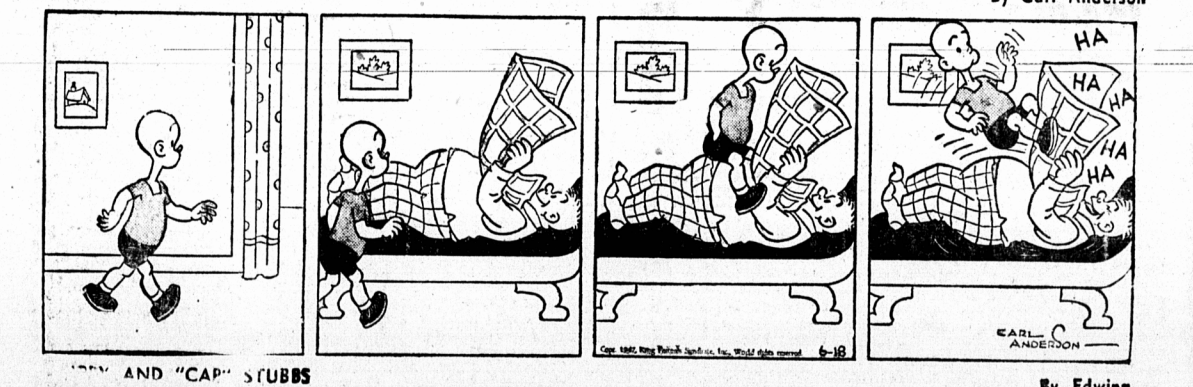
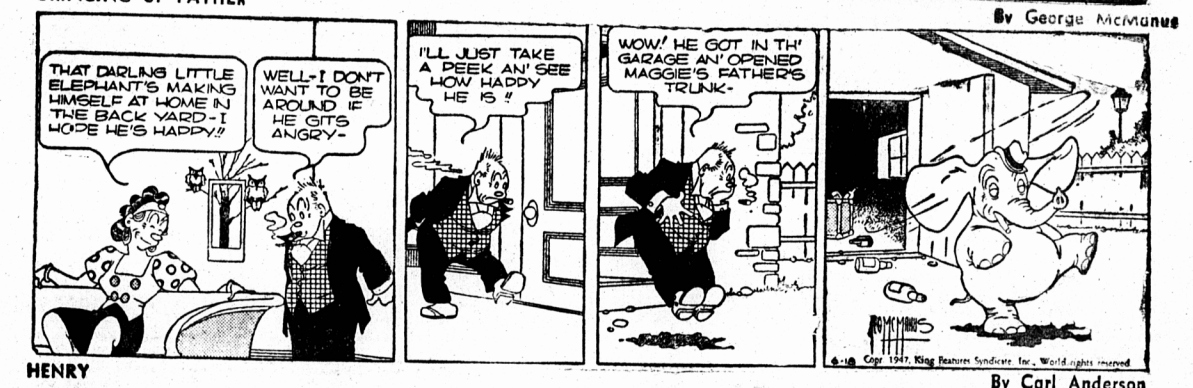
It is interesting to observe that both of these objectives were realized. South discovered that West had no strength, and apparently he did succeed in trapping West into a penalty double of highly dubious soundness.

South made his doubled three-spade contract without much trouble, winning six spades and a club in his own hand, and taking two diamond tricks with dummy's help.
