Entries for the Agricultural Merit Competition must reach the Department of Agriculture this month. The Island is divided into 6 districts now instead of 3, which should bring out more entries. It is worth entering the competition to have the Judge give his opinion of your method of farming.

A very special and interesting service, for children will be given in the S. A. Hall tomorrow, Wednesday evening, at 7 p. m. Singing, music, and stereopticon pictures, will form a prominent part. Free tickets are being given to all children under fifteen. Don't fail to secure tickets and send the children along.

Beginning June 20th there will be three direct trips a week from St. John to Boston by the popular Eastern Steamship Company's steamers the Calvin Austin and Governor Cook. This will greatly convenience the travelling public as these ships are magnificently equipped for safety and pleasure. One of the ships leaves St. John at seven p. m. Tuesday, Friday and Saturday and Boston at ten a. m. Sunday, Monday and Thursday.

Anyone intending to bring in a resolution at the Prince County Farmer's Institute Convention which meets in Summerside on Tuesday, June 28th, should send a copy of the resolution to either the Secretary, C. W. Marchbanks, New Annapolis, or to the President, Joseph Taylor, Lower Preetown, as soon as possible. All resolutions must be in the hands of the Committee on Resolutions not later than noon of the day of the Convention.

The Annual Prince County Convention will be held in Summerside, June 28th, beginning at 9.30 a. m. There will be two sessions forenoon and afternoon. Prof Zavitz of the O. A. College will address the Convention at 10.00 a. m. Prof Zavitz has a reputation all over the Continent as one of the best Agricultural students in America, and his addresses alone should bring out a great many people. Many matters will come up for discussion at the Convention and it is hoped that every Institute in Prince County will send delegates.

The Department of Agriculture has been fortunate in again securing the services of C. M. MacRae of the Live Stock Branch, Ottawa, to address some Agricultural meetings in connection with Live Stock in this Province. A meeting was advertised for Webster's Corner for Wednesday, June 22nd, but on account of the Horse trot that is taking place at Johnston's River on this date this meeting will be cancelled. It is expected however, that it will be held later during the month of July. Every farmer in the Province should make an effort to hear Mr MacRae, as he has had a very wide experience all over Canada and the United States judging all kinds of Live stock. He is a good speaker and his addresses in the past have always been interesting.

THE BANK OF NEW BRUNSWICK CUPS ARE VERY HANDSOME.

ST. JOHN, June 12—The Exhibition Association yesterday afternoon received from an Upper Canadian firm of silversmiths the magnificent silver trophies presented by the Bank of New Brunswick for the best agricultural horse and best shorthorn bull exhibited at the approaching Dominion Exhibition in September. Each cup stands upon a massive ebony base and each is highly artistic in design. The cup to be awarded to the best agricultural horse stands twenty-four inches high, is richly lined in gold and suitably engraved. The cup to be awarded the best shorthorn bull is edged with filigree silver

and engraved as well. Both trophies are on exhibition in the establishment of Allan Gundry, Prince William Street, and are attracting a great deal of attention. The exhibition management urges all citizens in the city and province to send in the names of relatives and friends living in the United States and outstanding sections of the Dominion—people who might decide to visit St. John during the exhibition if supplied with concise information relative to the special rates on transportation lines. As each name is handed in to the central office in the Bank of Montreal building or mailed to Box 411, printed matter will be mailed to these distant folks forthwith. It is by this means that the

hustling town of Amherst has been able to assure itself of a great homecoming next month. The corps of canvassers who have been scouring the city for the last few days in the interests of the exhibition board and lodging bureau, is meeting with a great deal of success. Householders are realizing that in order to make the approaching Dominion Exhibition a thorough success must be comfortably housed and agreeably fed. With this in mind many people who have not in the past thrown their doors open to strangers are promising to do so this autumn, and have given the exhibition representatives definite information for use when the applications come rolling in at headquarters.
