North's overbidding in today's deal put his side in an absurd contract, but with considerable skill and several times as much luck, South saved the ship.

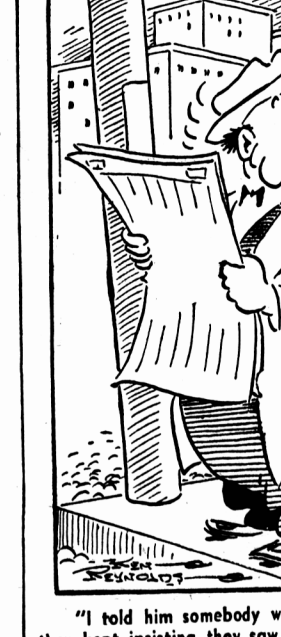
North-South were not using any four-notrump convention, and therefore South was under no obligation to make a further response. Nevertheless, North's four notrump was inexcusable. He had already announced a very big hand by jumping to three clubs. Since any response more constructive or encouraging than three notrump—indeed, South had had to strain to make even that response! North should have been well satisfied to drop the bidding. As a matter of fact, it would have been more logical for North to bid two notrump over South's one heart.

West opened his fourth-highest spade, and the moment South saw the dummy, he knew that he would need plenty of luck to win ten tricks. After deep thought, South won the first trick with the spade ace, cashed the heart ace and led the eight toward his own hand. East ducked, hoping to build an extra heart trick for his side, but declarer had a little chicanery but to put up the queen, which, of course, heid. Now that two heart tricks were home, declarer decided to try for a miracle in diamonds. He

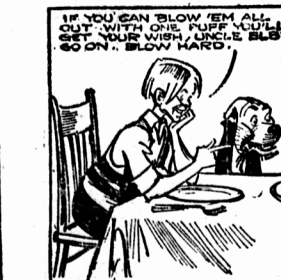

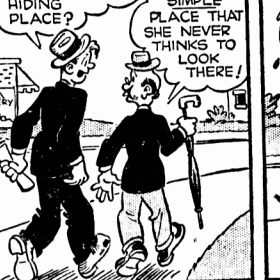

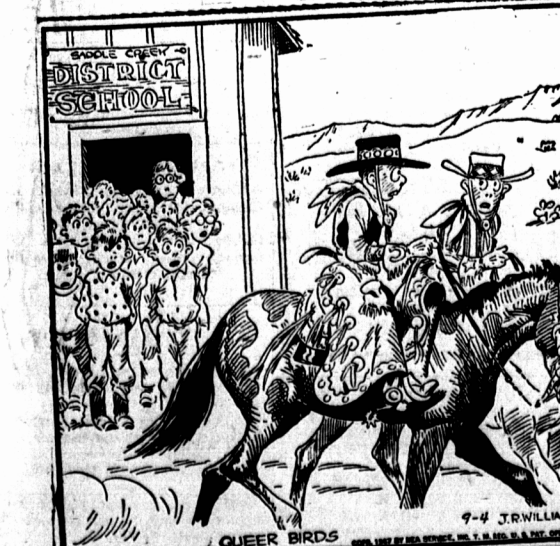
