A TEA GOWN OF THE FIRST EMPIRE.

There is a very fetching charm to this tea gown that brings back the days of Napoleon and Josephine and the exquisite dressing of the Court of the First Empire. The gown is really a double dress, and displays the characteristic short-waist and flowing-skirt effects of that period. The underdress is entirely of white double chiffon, or chiffon cloth, as it is so often called. A band of embroidered lace passes across the bust, and to this the full chiffon skirts are shirred, falling in straight, loose folds to the feet. The coat overdress is in a pale green Henrietta, with reverses and belt in white chiffon broadcloth, lined with an elegance of sage green velvet, and the skirts to the coat follow precisely the same lines as the under-dress, except that they stop short several inches of the latter. The back is disposed with a bias seam in the center, the fullness thus increasing all the way from shoulder to hem. The sleeve is a loose bell design, with an under-sleeve of embroidered chiffon and lace, which is meant to be worn or omitted, as caprice may dictate.

"ANGLO-FRENCH CORDIAL UNDERSTANDING"

M. DeLasse Points out Why France and Britain Must Remain Good Friends.—In Case of War England Under Present Conditions Could Annihilate the Ports of France.

PARIS, July 12.—Former Foreign Minister DeLasse, in the course of an interview published by the Galois today upon the British and French naval amenities at Brest, was induced to discuss the general policy relative to Great Britain and Germany.
He said: "The policy of nations now-a-days is not based on sentiment or antipathy, but upon their material interests. As between Germany and Great Britain our commercial balance shows where our interests lie. Great Britain is our best purchaser, while Germany buys almost nothing of us and tries to sell us all she can.
It is evident we could not leave open irritating controversies with Great Britain which might precipitate an armed struggle, for Great Britain holds in-

disparately the Empire of the Seas. For every warship we build she builds four on five. It is therefore well to accept these manifest facts and consider the value which British co-operation would give us in certain eventualities. The greatest intrinsic value of such co-operation would be the virtual impossibility in which it would place Germany of making war upon us.
M. DeLasse was asked if he considered the recent menaces in connection with Morocco as being serious. He replied "Not at all. In case of war Great Britain would be surely with us against Germany and then what would the infant fleet of Germany amount to?
"What would become of her ports, of her commerce, of her merchant marine? It would mean annihilation. That is the real significance of the present exchange of visits between the British and French squadrons. An understanding between these powers would create a machine so powerful that neither Germany nor any other power would risk conclusions upon the sea. It is the sea which it is necessary to command today, and the war in the Far East has conclusively demonstrated this."
Continuing M. DeLasse discussed the possibility of the policy which had been pursued. "Anglo-French cordial understanding," he said, "was an achievement toward a definite understanding between Russia and Great Britain and this further understanding would have been the work of the French Minister for Foreign Affairs. The success of such a task would have strengthened our influence in British councils, and assured for a long time the peace of the world."
In conclusion Minister DeLasse was asked for his opinion of France's accepting a conference on Morocco to which he gave the following textual response: "To go to a conference is a mistake, and such a mistake."
LIGHTNING PLAYS HAVOC.
RENFREW, Ont. July 12.—Lightning caused a panic here tonight during the Orange celebration. Closely following the arrival of the procession at the park, a thunder storm broke. A bolt of lightning shattered a tree and knocked five persons unconscious. All were revived and none seemed seriously injured.
The bolt also tore the banner of Ottawa Lodge, 227, into shreds, and knocked down a team of horses.

The present programme contemplates that the naval militia of Connecticut, New Jersey and Pennsylvania be taken out on Aug. 5, that of Massachusetts and Rhode Island on Aug. 19, and that of Maine on a date yet to be fixed. It was stated at the department last night that the department's plans, probably the first division of his squadron, might be brought north from Dominican waters for these cruises, leaving the other division on duty there.

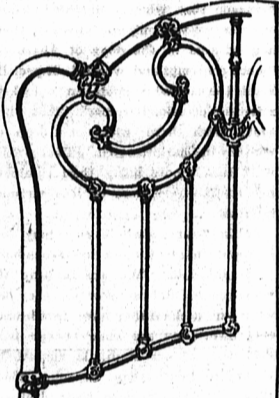

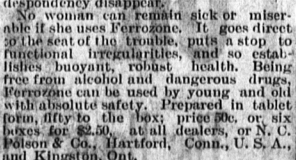
