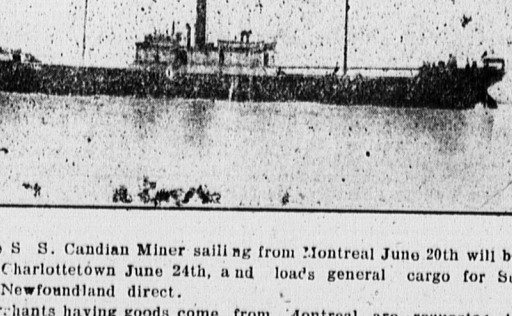

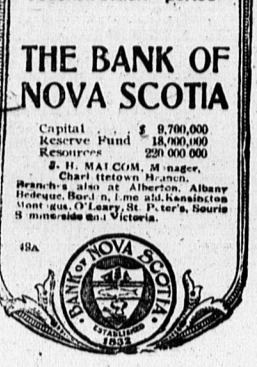

BY ALBERT L. CLOUGH A FEW EMERGENCY "KINKS" When Far From A Garage A Little Resourcefulness Is Valuable

In event of failure of the vacuum-system to fill and supply gasoline to the carburetor, the engine can be run for a time on fuel poured into the top of the vacuum tank, through the opening that is closed by a removable plug. Draw gasoline from the bottom of the main tank into a bottle or tin can, run the vacuum tank, about half full, into the vacuum tank, about a pint of gasoline. The average car will run a mile or two on this amount, and the operation can be repeated if necessary.

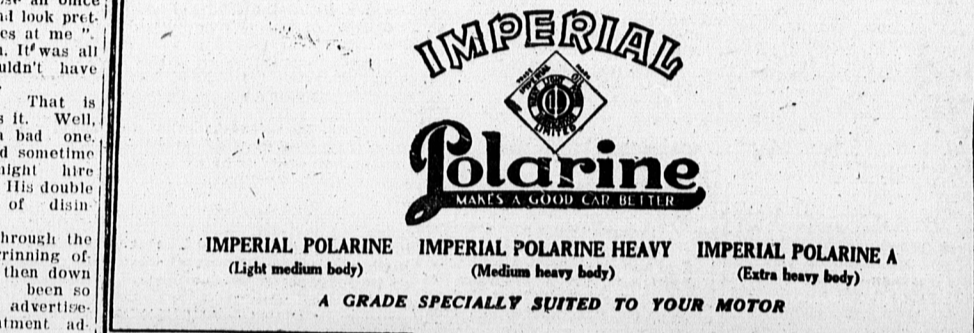

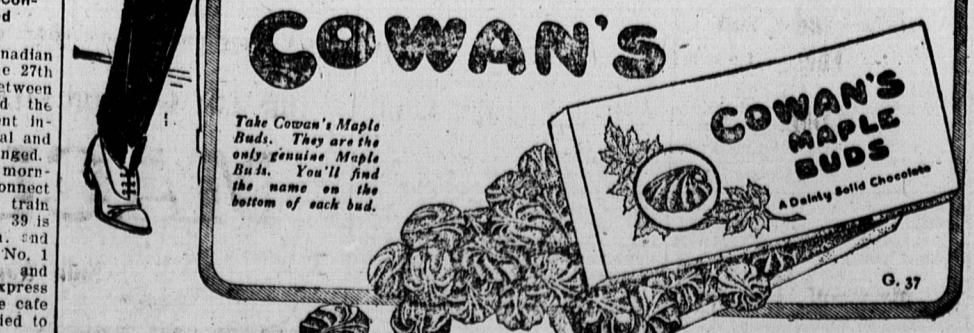
