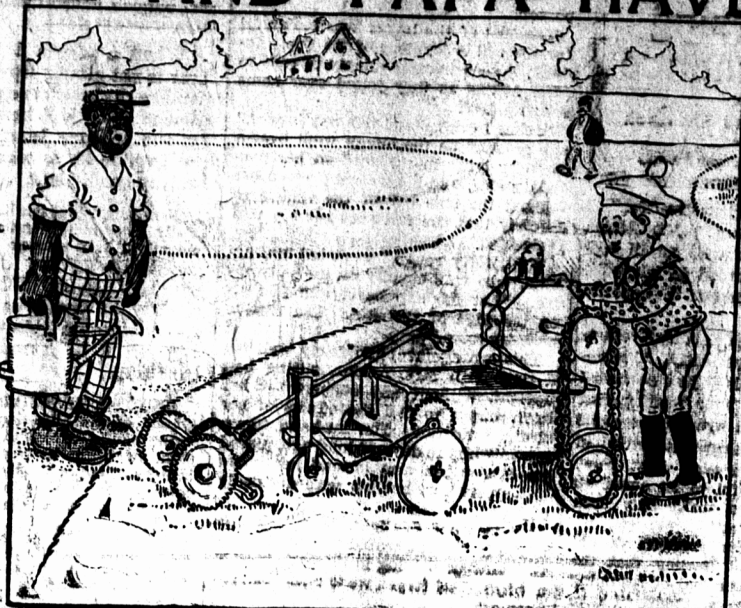
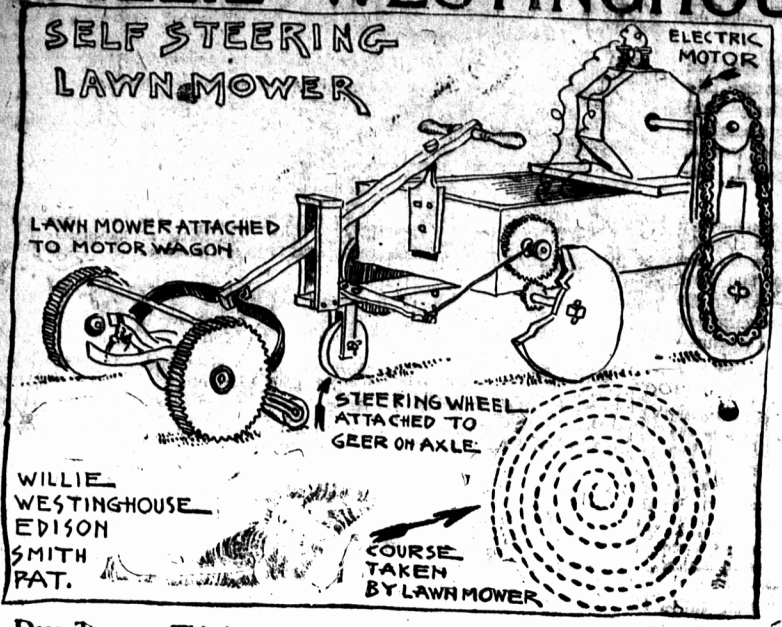


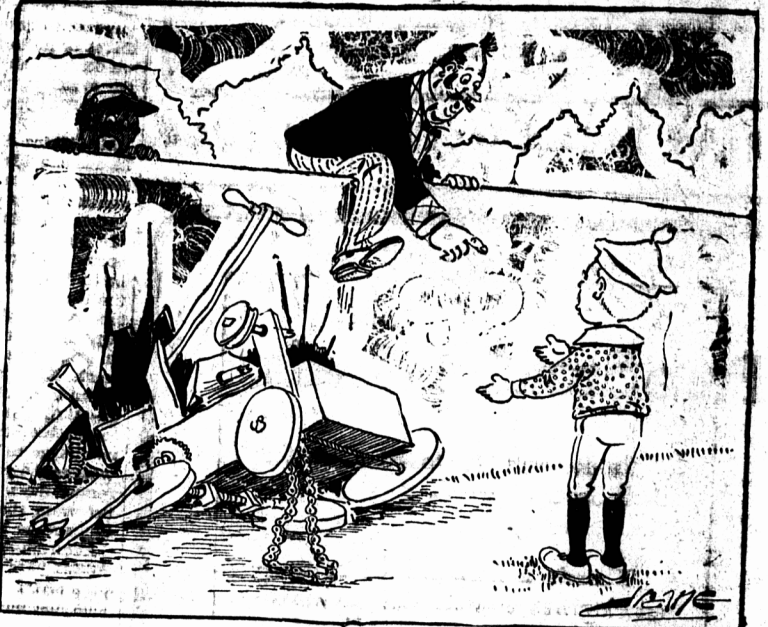
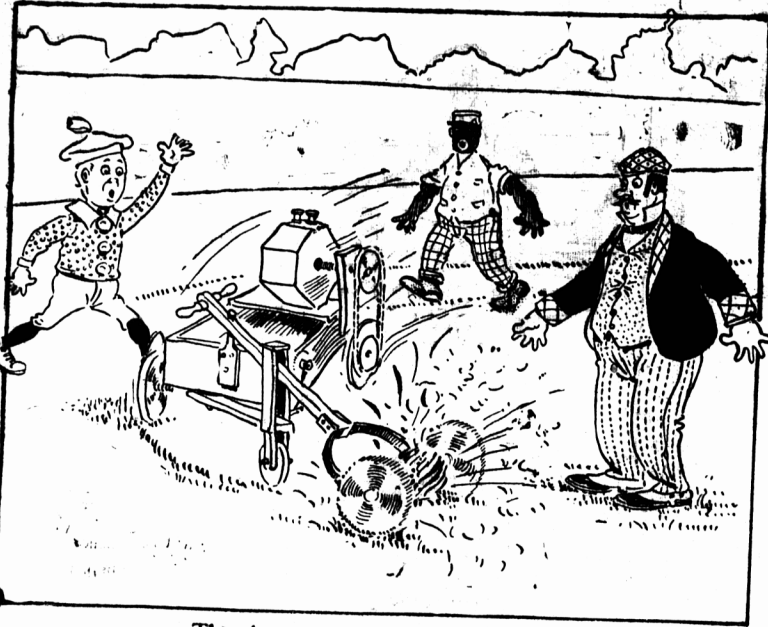
WILLIE WESTINGHOUSE AND PAPA HAVE A NARROW ESCAPE

It's a great labor saver, and Papa said he would get it patented.

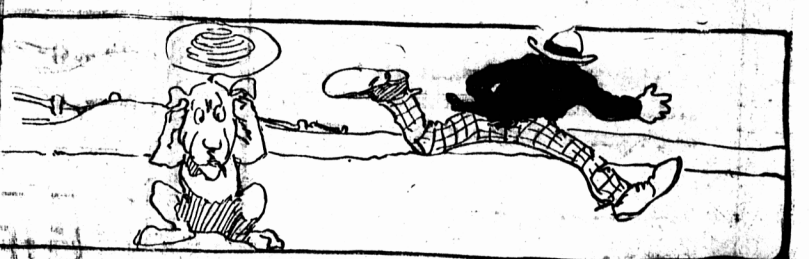
It was running beautifully, when the cord leading to the axle broke.
