## MOER MARTYRS OF RONTGEN RAYS

### Dauntless Workers in London Hospital Caught Fatal Disease While Making Experiments for the Benefit of Science

LONDON, England April 12.—Three heroes in the cause of humanity are to-day working in the London Hospital. The recent case of Dr. Hall Edwards, of Birmingham, who, as a result of his X-ray investigation

had to have his arm amputated, has drawn attention to them.

The London Hospital was a pioneer in the enterprise of treating disease by the use of X-rays. During the eleven years its radiographic department has been in operation hundreds of poor sufferers have been cured of their cases have been alleviated.

In the department are Mr. Har-nack Mr. Wilson and Mr. Blackhall, acting under the direction of the doctors. To-day each of them is suffering as a result from X-ray dermatitis, an incurable disease.

The hands of Mr. Wilson and Mr. Blackhall are coated from the nails to the knuckles with dried cancerous ulcers, which are steadily eating away the hands and spreading up the arms.

Mr. Wilson has recently lost one finger, and another is threatened.

Mr. Blackhall, whose arm is in a sling as the result of an operation only a few days ago, was in a worse state, if anything, than his colleague. The pain at times is excruciating.

Mr. Blackhall was asked why he did not take a holiday. "I have cases of poor sufferers from lupus, rodent ulcers, ringworm, and cancerous cases, and am booked up to January next."

Such is the spirit which animates these workers for humanity. Facing and fighting death, they are patiently plodding alike in the interests of science and the public good.

## EXPERIENCE OF SEAL FISHERMEN

### Two Perished in the Mag-dalens--Boats Got Astray in Snowstorm.

HALIFAX, April 12.—A thousand seals were landed today at the Mag-dalen Islands, making a total catch to date of seven thousand. Arthur Bourgeois and his son gave out with exhaustion on the ice and perished before help reached them. Four boats and their respective crews of eight and ten men, overtaken by snow squalls and shifting wind, landed safely on Byron Island and their escapes from a most horrible death is nothing short of miraculous.

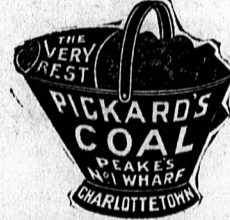
