Synopsis of Canadian Northwest Land Regulations.

ANY person who is the sole head of a family, or any male over 18 years of age, may become a settler under the provisions of the Dominion Land Act in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The settler must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency or Sub-Agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any Agency, on certain conditions, by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of the intending homesteader.

Duties—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of three years. A homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead or in a town or village. He may own and occupy by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister, in certain cases, a quarter section along side his homestead. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties, plus, residential, amount of six years from date of homestead entry (including the time required to earn homestead patent) and child the city, etc.

A homesteader who has exhausted his home- stead right and cannot obtain a re-emption may lease a purchased homestead in certain districts. Price \$3.00 per acre. Duties—Must reside six months in each of three years, cultivate city, etc.
