CANADIAN PARTIES AND THE DEFENCE OF THE EMPIRE.

A Government whose majority came almost wholly from the Province of Quebec, as was the case with the late federal Administration, was of necessity largely controlled by the wishes and sentiments of the people of that Province, and Quebec was reluctant to take any share in the preparation for the defence of the Empire, outside of Canada.

The views of the leading members of the Borden Cabinet in regard to this matter are well known in their general outline. Mr. Borden, Colonel Hughes, Hon. Mr. White, Hon. Mr. Hazen and others have from time to time spoken out as to the duty of Canada assuming her fair share of the task of defending the Empire, in which we have so large a stake.

"At present the world is at peace. Let us hope it will remain so. In

order to maintain peace it is necessary to be strong, and that is the reason the five nations are getting together, not for aggression, but for defence. That the parliament and people of Canada will be prepared to do its full share in the matter of imperial defence, I entertain no manner of doubt."

Such sentiments are not by any means congenial to the Nationalists of Quebec. The extremists among them are in a huff. A telegram to the Toronto Globe, announcing the results of the recent provincial election, told that many of them voted for the candidates of the Gouin Government. On the eve of the election Mr. Bourassa went away to England, declining to take further part in the open opposition to Sir Lomer. Mr. Armand Lavergne, who remained and took part with the Opposition, in explaining their defeat, says, "We were beaten by the navy question and by the school question." Le Canada, Liberal, says, "The Conservative wave last fall was the voice of Ontario. This triumph is the voice of Quebec."

And simultaneously the attacks of the Liberal press upon the Nationalists have ceased. The "unholy alliance," between Conservatives and Nationalists is no longer conspicuous in the headlines of Liberal political news. But when the re-alignment of parties is completed a similar headline may be made descriptive in the Conservative press of the restored accord between the Quebec Liberals and Nationalists. Such is politics and such are the exigencies of party journalism.

THE CABLE WORKING.

After a two months interruption the electric cable connecting this Province with the mainland has been restored to working order. During the continuance of the break much public and private inconvenience was experienced which it may be hoped will not recur for a long time to come. But something more than this is wanted. The Province must be placed on the same footing as other parts of Canada in regard to electric service. This it has never yet attained to. It has been treated as a sort of back settlement of Can-

ada which ought not to expect the same conveniences and privileges as New Brunswick or Nova Scotia.

For more than thirty years after the union with Canada we had no night service by telegraph and our people were compelled to pay double rates for both private and press messages. The company exacted it and the Dominion and provincial Governments allowed it. It was only after a long and hard fight that the improved service and reduced rates of the past few years were secured.

Down to the present we have been left without the privileges of the reduced night rates and the night letter, long since accorded to nearly all the civilized world outside of Prince Edward Island.

ROOSEVELT CARRIES OHIO.

COLUMBUS, O., May 21.—On the face of the early returns in Ohio's first presidential preference primary today, Col. Theodore Roosevelt led the Republican ticket by 3 to 2 over President Taft, and Governor Woodrow Wilson of New Jersey led the Democratic ticket by about the same percentage. Later returns, however, seemed to favor Governor Harmon and reduce Col. Roosevelt's majority.

gather an indication of the number of delegates either President Taft or Col. Roosevelt have gained.

President Taft appeared to have carried Cincinnati by a large margin and also Toledo and Dayton among the larger cities. This was more than offset by the vote given Col. Roosevelt in Cleveland, Columbus and other cities. The Roosevelt lead in the north end of the State it seemed would give the former President an advantage which Mr. Taft could not overcome by his vote in the south end of the State, including Cincinnati, his home and the rural districts.

Senator La Follette received a larger vote than State politicians had predicted for him, getting a considerable fraction of the vote cast in the northern end of the State, including Cleveland.

Governor Wilson, like Col. Roosevelt, was given his biggest vote in the city of Cleveland and the surrounding counties.

Governor Harmon polled a heavy vote in Columbus, the capital, and also in his home city, Cincinnati. No definite result can be announced however, until morning.
