Law which is violated in its least commandment violates the whole and breaks it down. The man at the switch is as important to the safety of railroading as the one at the signal-box or in the despatch office. All the tunnels and cables and signals and sum total of the outfit of the mine are brought to disaster by the torch which breaks the law of fire-damp.

Anger is a bad thing. It is harder on the subject of it than upon the object of it—a great deal. In every way this anger makes out a big score against it, and so do the Scriptures. And this is why the law of love tells the one who believes that he is the unhappy cause of the anger of another to get the matter adjusted at once. It is un-Christian to permit another to suffer where it is possible to make things right. It is more important to do this than to converse prayers or incantations. These are blasphemous while the other is neglected. Love cannot have it so.

Perfection comes through following the copy. Your Heavenly Father—the copy Divine. Behold, how He ministers! To the unworthy and the thankless and the wicked as fully and faithfully as to the just. He satisfied Himself in the principles of His own righteousness. It is for us to "walk in the light, even as He is in the light."

And when what He says is obeyed, and when His interpretation of the law of love is followed a fuller righteousness is manifest, both in understanding and in character, than by those who went about to establish their righteousness by the deeds of the law. Their righteousness is exalted, not because the law has been changed, but because it has been amplified and universalized and exalted by its living and adorable exponent Christ and embodiment, even Jesus Christ.

A recent work in theology, of great value, takes the lesson for today and similar passages as the basis for a study upon what the writer is pleased to state as "The legislative consciousness of Jesus." It is an argument in support of the definite claim which is made of our Lord's perfect divinity. Words such as these, "Ye have heard that it was said . . . but I say unto you," reveal a right of legislation which can only belong to One who speaks for God in a way that one less than God could not speak without illimitable presumption.
