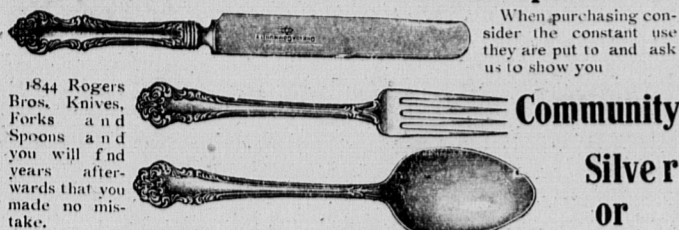

Rev. David Hutchinson left last evening for Ontario. He will join Mrs. Hutchinson and Miss Hutchinson in the Gatineau region, near Ottawa, where the family will camp for six weeks. The semi-annual examination which took place at Milroy School, June 29th, was largely attended. There were twenty-six visitors and thirty-two pupils present. The pupils were examined in the various subjects by Rev. P. D. McGuigan of Tracadie Cross, James Murphy of St. Dunstan's College, William Grant of McGill College, and Bernard McIntyre, teacher at Grand Tracadie. The pupils, by their prompt and precise answers, showed that they had a creditable knowledge of their work, and that they had been carefully taught by their teacher, Miss Bertha A. Martin. All visitors present commented highly on the discipline of the pupils and the satisfactory standing of the school in general.

The annual school meeting of Corraville was held on Tuesday, June 21, nearly all the rate payers being present. Patrick Sharkey was elected chairman, Daniel MacAulay was proposed for trustee by Pius MacMillan, and the motion was seconded by Edmund Flynn and he was almost unanimously elected. The amount of money voted in for repairs was very little when compared with last year, and the amount voted in for the running expenses was the same as usual with the exception of lighting the fire and banking the house. Patrick Morrison spoke favoring a supplement, and he was opposed by Pius MacMillan, which ended in a very lively debate in which a great many of the rate payers took part especially Patrick Morrison, Pius MacMillan, John Sigsworth, Edmund Flynn and Edward Sharkey. At the end of the debate Patrick Morrison proposed a \$10.00 supplement seconded by Edward Sharkey, but their motion was lost. Edward Sharkey, Patrick Morrison and D. S. Wilson voted for the supplement and Pius MacMillan, John Sigsworth, Edmund Flynn, Joseph McKimmin, Edmund Flynn and Daniel MacAulay voted against it.
