Nun's Will Suit
It was seated during the hearing of a Probate suit at Liverpool that the plaintiff, Miss Katherine Perry, who for thirty-two years was a nun in the Convent of Notre Dame, Liverpool, was expelled for visiting her sister, the testatrix, who was on the point of death.

Overthrown by a Draught

Famous Relics Found

Remains 3,000 Years Old

Oldest Bachelor in England
Believed to be the oldest bachelor in England, Mr. Robert Orlinton of the Mardens, Caterham, celebrated the 102nd anniversary of his birth. He boasts that in the whole of his life he cannot recall having tasted any medicine. He was born in Fethisburgh, and is descended from the Orlintons of Cluny, the branch to which belonged "The Admirable Orlinton."
