Produce Prices

MONTREAL, April 9—(CP)—Butter and potato prices firmed while eggs gave ground narrowly on open produce markets here last week, the Dominion Department of Agriculture reported. Creamery butter prints to retailers sold for 23 1/2-24 cents a pound and solids for 22 1/2-23. Western butter was quoted, Quebec No. 1 pasteurized regraded in wholesale jobbing lots was 22 1/4. Ontario colored cheese brought 10 3/4-11 cents a pound. Grated egg shipments in used free cases were offered at 22 cents a dozen for A-large, 21 for A-medium, 20 for A-pullets, 19 for B-large and 18 for C. Potatoes: N. B. No. 1 mts 1.38-1.45; N. B. No. 2 mts 50's 85-87; P. E. I. No. 1 mts 90's 1.50-1.55; P. E. I. No. 1 whites 90's 1.45-1.50.

MONTREAL, April 9—(CP)—Pound Sterling advanced 7-16 to 4.70 11-16 and the United States dollar pushed up 3-32 to 1.00 9-16 on Montreal foreign exchange Saturday. French francs improved narrowly to close at 2.66 5-16. NEW YORK, April 9—(AP)—Major European currencies weathered another barrage of war news Saturday with support of official stabilization funds. The spot French franc dipped '00 3-16 of a cent to 2.64 3-4 while the pound remained unchanged at \$4.68 1-8. The Swiss franc advanced a trifle and the belga and gulder were narrowly lower. The Canadian dollar lost 1-32 to a discount of 9-16.
