Cancer Now Preventable Disease

(Canadian Press) NEW YORK, N. Y., Oct 15—Cancer may now be looked upon as a preventable disease, said Dr. Joseph Colt Bloodgood of Johns Hopkins University, Baltimore, at a meeting of the American College of Surgeons in Brooklyn. "We have ample evidence," Dr. Bloodgood said, "that the educational effort of the American Society for the control of cancer in combination with the medical profession, the health department and many intelligent and interested laymen and women have reduced the hopelessness of cancer, and undoubtedly increased the number of five year and permanent cures."
