The connection was made about half past nine in the evening, and, with the exception of two small interruptions lasting only a few seconds, the talk continued without interruption of any kind.

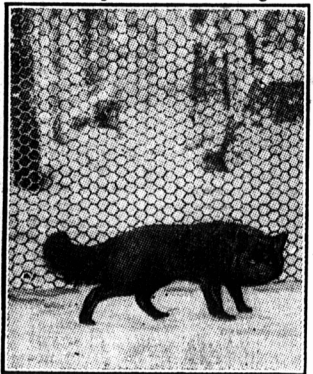
