Conspiracy Trial

SEATTLE, July 5-(AP)-The espionage conspiracy trial of Russian Navy Lieut. Nicolai Redin was in recess on this independence day anniversary. He is charged with conspiring to harm by obtaining secret data on the few-design destroyer tender Yellowstone.

Arguments last night on unsuccessful defence motions for directed verdicts of acquittal on the conspiracy and the espionage indictments, and for dismissal of the espionage counts, revealed that the Redin case is the only one in modern court history in which only one named person was indicted for conspiracy, the co-conspirators being described as "unknown."

Allan Pomeroy, assistant district attorney, said that law books list only one similar case. It was in the British courts of the 17th century, he said, and was singular in that every one actually knew the identity of the co-conspirators, but they were not named because of their prominence.

Commenting on the defence motions, which he denied in the jury's absence, district Judge Lloyd Black said there were no listed precedents declaring the Redin indictments were not "good" in law.
