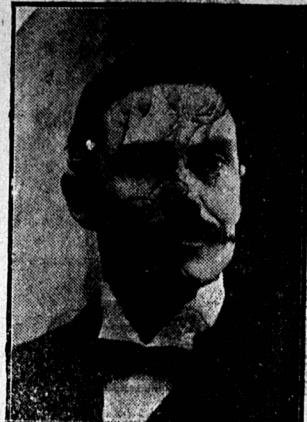
THE DOMINION ALLIANCE ASK FOR NEW SUNDAY LAW

HAULTAIN'S VICTORY IN SASKATCHEWAN ELECTIONS

He Carries Eighteen Out of Twenty—Three Contested Seats—Liberals Get Five Seats by Polling and one By Acclamation—Crushing Defeat of Scott's Government.

REGINA, Dec. 13.—(Special) Returns from the elections in Saskatchewan are as yet incomplete, but it is practically certain that Haultain has carried eighteen out of the twenty-three contested seats, leaving five Liberals elected by polling and one by acclamation.

Haultain himself has a splendid majority and is receiving many congratulatory telegrams.

of the twenty-five seats Haultain's party has captured nine, the Liberals have six, while the remainder, chiefly in the northern districts are still in doubt and will not be heard from until tomorrow but probably most of them will go Liberal.
