TRIPOLI, Oct. 31.—(By Wire)—For three days the Italians have been systematically slaughtering rebels in the residential oasis outside the city. Every Arab met has been shot down without trial and many women have been killed.

CONSTANTINOPLE, Oct. 31.—(By Wire)—Turkish troops with their Arab allies have retaken two forts at Tripoli and forced the Italians to entrench themselves within the city after abandoning large numbers of guns, rifles, ammunition and provisions.

NEW YORK, October, 30.—President Taft is to be asked to transmit to the Senate of Russia a protest formulated with a meeting today by New York clergymen of all denominations against the "systematic oppression" of the Jews in Russia. The protest is in the form of a resolution setting forth the "unjust and barbaric conditions" to which, it is declared, the Jews in that country are subjected.

PEKIN, Oct. 31.—(By Wire)—The state of terror which has taken possession of the entire imperial court was further evidenced today by a long list of edicts supplementing yesterday's remarkable proclamation and offering further concessions of a radical character.

PEKIN, Oct. 31.—The demand of the National Assembly for a complete constitutional government has been the sincerity of the Imperial edicts acceded to the Throne. An imperial edict was issued yesterday apologizing for past neglect and granting an immediate Constitution with a Cabinet from which the nobles shall be excluded.

OTTAWA, Nov. 1.—(By Wire)—According to reports received by the Commission, two-thirds of the construction work on the Winnipeg-Moncton section of new line has been completed.

BOSTON, October, 31.—On a charge of murdering Miss Avis Linnell, of Hyannis, Rev. Clarence N. T. Richeson, pastor of Immanuel Baptist Church, is on trial in the County Court in special sessions today. The indictment is on five counts. The indictment follows in part:

The immediate cause of death was given as pneumonia, but this had been caused by a "bullet wound in the lung. It took eight policemen and special constables to induce the man's wife to give up the body. How the man was shot is the problem which the police are endeavoring to unravel.

MELBOURNE, Nov. 1.—The mail train running between Sydney and this city met with a disaster shortly after midnight, although none of the passengers were killed, thirty persons were seriously injured. Many were asleep in their berths when the train running full speed crashed into a stock train at Pictou, which is on the way to Sydney from Goulburn.

HALIFAX, Nov. 2.—(By Wire)—Upwards of 700 enthusiasts representing all the Provinces of Canada attended the complimentary banquet tendered Premier Borden tonight.

TOKIO, Nov. 2.—(By Wire)—Revolutionary activity at Mukden is rumored, following reports intimating the danger of an uprising in other parts of Manchuria.
