ANTI-STRIKE LEGISLATION.

The Australian colonies have been noted among the British possessions not only for Government ownership of railways and telegraphs but for very advanced labor legislation. It has been recently found that Government ownership entails a very serious danger.

The tremendous voting power of the laboring class in a country like New Zealand, where manhood and womanhood suffrage prevails now becomes apparent. All the adult population are voters there, and while quite willing to abide by decisions of the arbitration boards when such decisions were in their favor they now unite to demand the repeal of the compulsory arbitration law because the decisions of the arbitrators are against them.

Holland is the latest of the countries to deal with anti-strike legislation. In that country, as in New Zealand the railways are mainly owned and operated by the Government, and last year there was a great railway strike which for a long term quite paralyzed transportation and entailed enormous losses.

The great majority of the workmen in the country are opposed to this legislation and if it is forced through the Legislature they threaten a general strike in all the departments in which labor is employed.

Sir Thomas Shaughnessy, new in London, hopes to see the Fast Line contract settled before his return. In the meantime a special cable from Montreal to the London Daily Mail says the call for tenders is only a bluff, as the Canadian Pacific already have the promise of the contract.

The London Advertiser is doubtful whether Marconi has been really sending wireless messages across the Atlantic and challenges him to prove it to the satisfaction of a jury made up of four London and four New York journalists.

For a long time while the Conservatives were in power the Liberal newspapers from year to year printed the Auditor General's report of the amounts paid to various newspapers by the Government for printing and advertising.
