To Probe Black Market in Meat

MONTREAL, June 26—(CP)— The Prices Board lined up tonight a campaign to beat a black market in meat in Montreal by taking over direction and allocation of the sale of dressed meat reaching this city.
Alfred Savoie, prices and supply representative of the Board, said the current shortage of meat in Montreal—not serious but noticeable to housewives—was seasonal.
"We always have a shortage at this time of the year but this year it is aggravated by black market operations," he said. Asked how extensive the black market sales were he replied only that, "there are some."
