Once Noted Forger Jailed For 5c Fraud

NEW YORK, Jan. 31—Charles Fischer, 70 years old, with an international criminal record running back fifty-eight years, was sentenced to ten days in the Tombs yesterday in Special Sessions for dropping a slug in the turnstile in the subway station at Broadway and Seventy-ninth street on January 3rd.

The record of Fischer's career in this country and Europe was read to the court by Peter Berry, chief investigator for the Laboratory. It said that Fischer admitted that he became a forger at his birthplace in Germany when he was 12 years old, and finally became such an annoyance to bankers that the American Bankers Association awarded a life pension to him to bring his depredations to an end.

Fischer paid his passage to America when he was 18 by forging a check on his employer in Germany. He organized a band of German criminals here. One "squealed" on him and he was sent to the House of Refuge for eight months. He was arrested often after he was released, in time he organized a band of forgers which victimized many Chicago banks.

Fischer frequently escaped prison terms the record showed, by turning State's evidence against accomplices. Eventually he got ten years in Sing Sing after a band of forgers had defrauded New York banks of more than \$100,000.

While in the Ossining prison, Fischer organized another group of forgers. When the members were released in 1893 they toured the country dressed as letter carriers. They robbed mail boxes or got checks. After raising the stolen checks to large amounts they cashed them. Thus they collected several hundred thousand dollars.

Fischer was arrested in Cincinnati in 1895 for forgeries there after the American Bankers Association had offered a large reward for him. He escaped from jail while awaiting sentence and fled to London.

He was sentenced to nine months imprisonment there for robbery and in 1897 was extradited to this country. He was imprisoned for three years on the conviction in Cincinnati. Then he was sent back to London and spent two years in Old Bailey for theft from letter boxes. Later he received a five year sentence in Old Bailey for counterfeiting. On his release he came to this country once more, only to be sent to Sing Sing for two years for forgery.

The last time Fischer was arrested in this country was in 1914, when Judge Rosalsky in General Sessions sentenced him to two years, as usual, for forgery. It was when he was released that time that the American Bankers Association decided to pension him in the hope that he would quit harassing bankers.

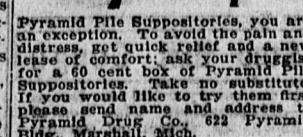

THE OLDEST INN

One of the oldest and best preserved fourteenth century inns in England is the George Inn, at Norton St. Philip, a picturesque little village near Bath. It is a half-timbered house, with walls three feet thick, and was licensed as an alehouse in 1397. And it has historic interest, as the Duke of Monmouth and Oliver Cromwell slept beneath its roof—the Duke of Monmouth on the night of June 26, 1685, just before the battle of Sedgemoor. There is a small oak

chair of the same period which was used in this bed-room; and the massive oak door is intact and shows the same strong iron bolt which used to secure it in those far-off days. Also may be seen some old oak settees and several deep oak cupboards; and the rooms contain much fine old paneleding.
