CHICKENS AND ANGLERS SUPPLIED WITH EARTHWORMS BY ELECTRICITY

Two Brass Rods Connected by Wires, With Telephone Magneto, the New Device Which Will Enroll Inventor Among Benefactors of the Race.

GREENWICH, Conn., Sept. 15.—That Peter O'Keefe, son of Mr. and Mrs. William O'Keefe, of Greenwich Avenue, Greenwich, is entitled to enrollment among the great benefactors of the race, is shown in a unique device he conceived for supplying poultry with earthworms by electricity.

The process consist in pushing two brass rods into the earth, several feet apart, a wire being attached to each rod, and the ends of the wires being connected with an ordinary telephone magneto.

The view of the government is that the military situation between Greece and Turkey cannot affect its views on the general question of peace between the Allies and Turkey, but that anything affecting in the slightest degree the freedom of the Dardanelles will not be tolerated, since there is no question of relinquishing what was won in the world war.

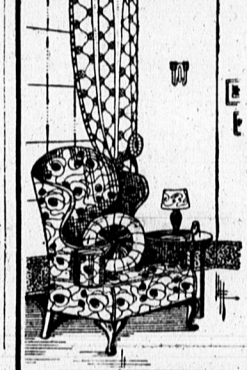
