IN MEMORIAM

MR. JAMES McDONALD

Today we regret to announce the death of James McDonald, a well-known resident of Kelly's Cross. Deceased was a progressive, thrifty, industrious man, and for many years carried on a successful blacksmith and carriage business. Besides attending to his farming operations. His genial, cheerful disposition gained many friends and made him a favorite with young and old, and his death will be regretted by a wide circle of friends and acquaintances. Although deceased was well advanced in years, in mind he was clear and bright and in body active up till the beginning of his last illness, which set in about the first of January, of the present year and which medical treatment was unable to overcome. Among other good qualities, Mr. McDonald was most faithful in attending to his religious duties, and during his illness, the visits of his good pastor, Rev. Dr. Curran, were his greatest comfort and consolation. With calm resignation to the Divine Will and fortified by the last sacraments of Holy Church, on Saturday the 8th of April, in the eighty second year of his age, his soul peacefully went forth to its eternal reward. The funeral took place on Monday the 10th, at St. Joseph's Church where Requiem Mass was sung by Rev. Francis McDonald of St. Dunstan's University, nephew of deceased. The Pastor, Rev. Dr. Curran, officiated at the grave, after which the body was laid in its last resting place to await a glorious resurrection. Deceased leaves to mourn besides his wife, four daughters, Mrs. James H. Devereaux, Kelly's Cross; Mrs. P. S. Bradley, Charlottetown; Mrs. D. G. McDonald and Miss Carrie, trained nurse, Boston, both of whom had the consolation of reaching home before their father's demise, and two sons, John E. D. D. S., Calgary, and Anthony, Boston, to all of whom the sympathy of the community goes out in their bereavement. The pall bearers were: Cecil Devereaux, Bryon McDonald, Joseph Urins McDonald, William Carragher. May his soul rest in peace.

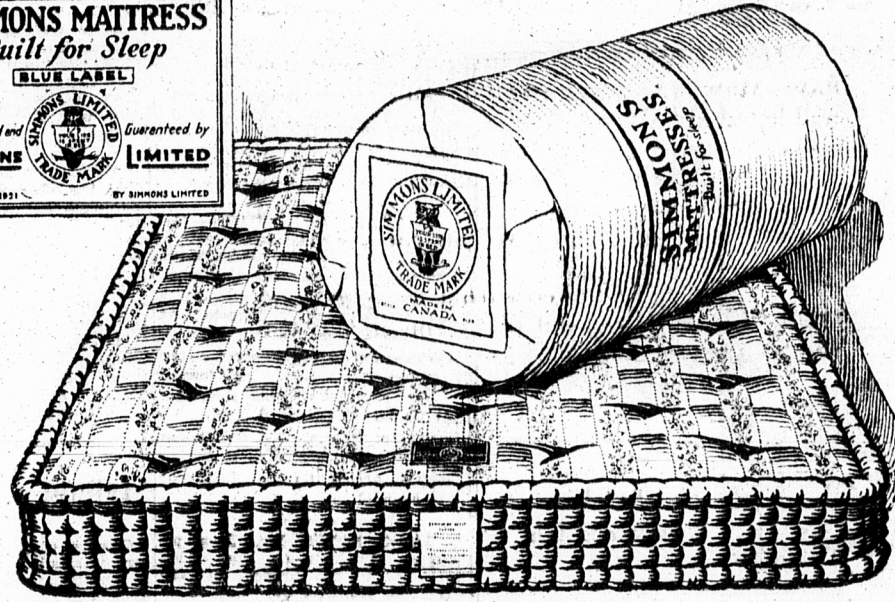
