TO DETECT HIDDEN WIRELESS STATIONS

WASHINGTON, Nov. 21.—Using a newly devised apparatus, naval experts are close on the trail of persons suspected of surreptitiously communicating by concealed wireless outfits with belligerent vessels on the Atlantic.

So far evidence has been secured implicating some persons in Florida, but the Maine woods mystery remains unsolved. Within a few days, however, detection of all such is regarded as inevitable.

The new instruments were perfected by American naval officers.

Secretary Bryan issued a statement today declaring that the United States, in making inquiries of its ministers in Ecuador and Columbia for information about alleged violations of neutrality, had no thought of interfering in the remotest way with the government of the Latin American countries.

Also, Mr. Bryan gave out in behalf of the Columbian legation here a statement reciting the efforts of the Columbian government to censor wireless telegraph stations.

The latter statement said:—“The Columbian Government has no wireless station on the Pacific coast at Cartagena, but the Government has a contract for full rights of inspection and censorship in case of war.

“Complaints have been made by the British legation that the office was not in the hands of a recognized expert the station was closed. Afterwards the Columbian government employed a professional expert and opened the station.

“Further complaints having been made against the employment of aliens all foreign employees were dismissed since that time it has been handled by the Government expert.

Later, a complaint has been made on the ground that plain words and phrases may be used with a conventional and secret meaning, but the Columbian government has not felt that this was a sufficient reason for closing the station to commercial purposes. This is the only pending question.

“Upon information received from the British legation that it feared the Germans might be hidden in Uraba and using occult stations, the government

made investigations at Cartagena, at Turbo and at Quibdo and found an abandoned ship, the Oscar of the Compania Bananera, with wireless apparatus out of use. A special official was sent to bring back the apparatus, and the British government tendered its thanks to the Government for its zeal.”

SPAIN AND ALLIES.

NEW YORK, November 22.—A cable from Madrid to the Tribune says:—

“It is said on good authority that a great secret agreement has been made by which the attitude of Spain will be more than friendly to the allies. According to this agreement, ‘Great Britain will not interfere with the shipments of conditional contraband to Spanish ports, the Spanish government giving a guarantee that no part of these ships are to be reshipped to Germany.

“The export trade from Spain will also be protected, and in return the Spanish government will see to it that the activities of German agents and spies which infest almost every neutral country are checked as much as possible in the Spanish dominions.

“According to this plan the government has requested all newspapers to print no news of French military activities in North Africa. It is said that German agents took advantage of such news and transmitted it to Germany.
