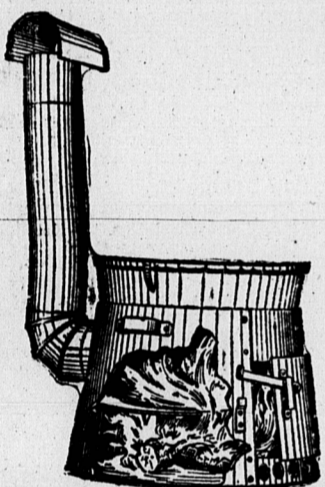

SUNDAY SCHOOL LESSON

LESSON V. OCTOBER 30.
THE ANOINTING OF JESUS.
Matt. 26: 1-16.

GOLDEN TEXT.
"She hath done what she could."
Mark 14:8.

POINTED SUGGESTIONS.
By Rev. D. W. Snider.

How very far apart men may be who sit side by side! What heaven-high or hell-deep motives are working the hearts and moulding the lives and determining the destinies of men who pass and mix and jostle and do business in the market-place!

See the varieties in motive and view-point and character which the lesson portrays in the priests and elders, in the disciples, in Simon the leper, in the woman with the cruse of precious ointment, in Judas, in Jesus.

Picture the deliberate, cold-blooded, thoroughly determined, malice-afore-thought way in which the priests and elders were set upon the killing of Jesus. Lawyers in their defence of men charged with murder make as much as they can for the benefit of the prisoner out of any semblance of facts which go to show that he entertained no malice against his victim and that the deed was not premeditated, etc., but no such plea can be made for the priests and elders. The facts are all the other way. Note verses four and five.

Picture, on the other hand the gratitude of Simon, the leper, towards Him, who had, doubtless, wrought a great work of healing upon him. And press the lesson of his gratitude, for many a one has been the recipient of great favors and has become doubly indebted to the skill and care and tenderness of others, and have scarcely said, "Thank you." Many a pastor and many a physician is well aware of that fact.

Picture, alongside of that, something still more beautiful. As gratitude cannot measure to the moral and spiritual dimensions of love, so this scene of the woman anointing the head of Jesus while He sat at meat is a scene more precious than that of the feast. It is the outpouring of love, which cannot be held in check by the proprieties, but rushes, with its sure intuition, to the accomplishment of those purposes which are supreme and which justify any cost.

Picture, in contrast, the calculators who would mar and spoil all lovely enterprises and throw the shadow of their covetousness or parsimony over all givers and gifts. And the worst of it is, they get wrothy over their contention in behalf of economy and their pretentious concern that other important interests should not suffer. But they fail to work except upon measures of blockade. Why? Because they do not let their hearts fire their brains.

Picture now the discriminating and sure quality of the judgment of Jesus. He sees through the indignation of the disciples, and gives them plenty to do in order to work out their pet ideas. But He also penetrates and understands the heart of the woman, and gives her commendation far beyond her dreams. She sought nothing but service, while Jesus gave her a never-ending reward.

Picture, once more, the traitor bargaining, like a Jew with cold-blooded Jews, for the betrayal of Jesus. No matter what he asked, when beaten down, he was willing to take for his Master the poor price of a slave. When men begin to sell their principles or the foundations upon which they rest they come all too soon to sell to the lowest bidder. And that fact is proven by every prodigal from God.

Nothing less than the best we can do is satisfactory to Jesus. Christian obligation demands that every ounce of ability be employed to meet it. "She hath done what she could." Less than that love will not give—and love is denied until it receives all.

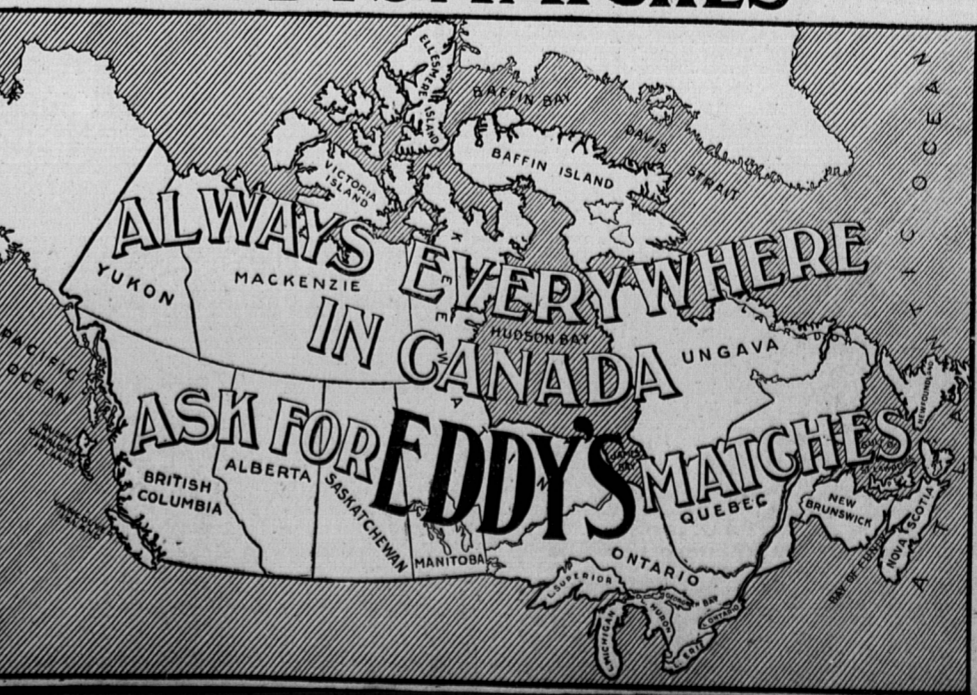
