

### SEEK CHARLTON WITNESSES HERE

NAPLES, Nov. 19, (Special)—Signor Giovanni Porzio and Signor Capapano, counsel for the defence in the case of Porter Charlton, the American, who is to stand trial at an early date at Como on a charge of having murdered his wife, returned from that place yesterday. They have prepared a long statement outlining circumstances which they allege are favourable to Charlton, and this will be submitted to the investigating judge tomorrow.

The attorneys say that about fifteen witnesses residing in New York State will be interrogated by a commission on Charlton's past life and the character of the Charlton couple. They are anxious to obtain the deposition of Mrs. Charlton's first husband, Mr. Neville H. Castle, formerly a lawyer of San Francisco. They hope to be able to induce the Crown Prosecutor to order an investigation by alienists of Charlton's mental state.

### BLACK DAYS FOR RUSSIAN JEWS

BERLIN, Nov. 19, (Special)—The Jewish leaders, who, in the realm of philanthropy on behalf of their oppressed co-religionists everywhere in Europe and the Orient, act and speak for the Jews of America, are convinced of the inconclusive result of the Kieff "ritual murder" trial and that it means blacker days still to come for the Jews in Russia.

Dr. Paul Nathan, president of the Central Jewish Federation of Germany, who ranks as the greatest authority on Jewish conditions in this hemisphere, has furnished a correspondent the following statement:

"From the criminological standpoint the Beliss trial, was utterly uninteresting. The persons who actually committed the crime are known in Kieff, and the police officials and the examining magistrate only had the task of conducting the proceedings in such a manner as to shield the real culprits.

"They succeeded in doing so; but it must be said, to the honor of Russian officialdom, that it was, nevertheless, not easy to accomplish this end. Several police officials had to be put out of the way because they had been so incautious and ruthless as to wish to elicit the truth, and the examining magistrate had to be changed for the same reason.

"Then recourse was had to medico-scientific expert testimony, which, as soon as it became known, was shattered with ridicule by the first authorities of Germany, England, France, Austria, and Switzerland.

"Finally a theological expert was discovered in a wretched Roman Catholic priest, who was to testify to the occurrence of Jewish ritual murders. This priest, Pranatis, a few years ago, wrote an important book called "Ritual Murder Among the Jews." It was an inferior compilation of anti-Semitic polemical casuistry, which had long since been effectually contradicted.

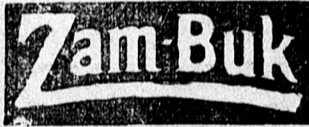
"Pranatis owed his summons as an expert wholly to the authorship of that book. One of his conferees in Tachkent made some extremely interesting revelations in regard to Pranatis's role as a theological expert, which exposed the secret influences at the back of the Beliss prosecution.

### Legislative Assembly



#### Rules Relating to Private Bills:

All petitions for Private Bills must be presented within fourteen days after the commencement of the Session exclusive of adjournment.

No Private Bill shall be brought into the House, but upon a Petition first presented, truly stating the case at the peril of the suitors for such Bill, and such petition must be signed by the said parties.

A committee shall be appointed at the commencement of every session consisting of five members, of whom three shall be a quorum to be denominated, "The Private Bills Committee," to whom shall be referred every Private Bill, and no proceeding after the first reading shall be had upon such bill until such committee has reported thereon to the House.

So soon as the Committee has reported any Bill, such Bill together with any amendments that may be suggested by the Committee, shall be printed at the expense of the parties who are suitors for such Bill, and printed copies thereof delivered to the members before the second reading, if deemed necessary by the Committee.

No Bill for the particular interests of any person or persons, Corporation or Corporations, or body, or bodies of people, shall be read a second time until all fees be paid for the same into the hands of the Clerk of the House.

No Bill having for its object the vesting in or conferring upon any person or persons, Municipality or Body Corporate the title to any tract of land shall be received or read in the House unless at least four weeks notice containing a full description of the land in question has been published in the ROYAL GAZETTE, and one other newspaper in this Province of the intention of such person or persons, Municipality or Body Corporate to apply for such Bill.
