**Contract Bridge**

**COUNT YOUR TRICKS**

Squeezes and coups of various descriptions may be the "fireworks" of bridge, but, strange to say, these are not as difficult as other deals which demand nothing but the careful counting of tricks! The declarer in today's deal was fully capable of executing the most involved sort of play, but he lost his redoubled contract because of carelessness.

**North dealer. Both sides vulnerable.**

♠ Q J  
♥ A K 5 3  
♦ 8 4 2  
♣ K J 9 8

♠ K 7 3 2  
♥ Q 10 9  
♦ 6 4  
♣ A Q 10 8

**The bidding:**

North	East	South	West
1♠	Pass	1♠	Pass
2♥	Pass	2♥	Pass
3NT	Double	Pass	Pass
Redouble	Pass	Pass	Pass

North's redouble was "sporty" and was probably based on supreme confidence in his expert partner. This time, however, South let him down.

East had doubled largely to call for a club or heart opening lead, but West's "disobedience" in opening the spade ten turned out very well for his side. East covered the jack with the king and declarer's side entry, the spade ace, was driven up then and there. South promptly laid down the diamond king, and he was not pleased when East showed out! In a desperate effort to maintain communications between dummy and the closed hand, South now led the diamond jack, hoping West would not so foolishly. He declined the trick, and now South saw that it was futile to go ahead with diamonds. He led a club toward dummy, hoping for at least one trick in that suit, but the hope was vain. East won and knocked out the spade jack, and after that declarer had to be satisfied with two top heart tricks and one more diamond. The redoubled contract was down two, for a penalty of 1,000 points!

If South had counted up to nine, he would have led the diamond jack at least the second trick, in careful anticipation of a bad diamond break. Then West held up the diamond ten would follow, and this time West would have to take his queen — "or else!"
