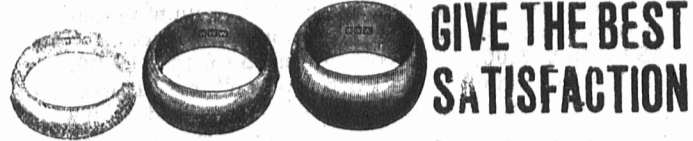

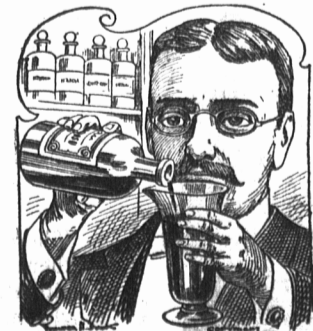

ALL NEWS OF LOCAL INTEREST

Reporters and Correspondents Everywhere.

The Liberal Conservative Convention yesterday in the B. I. S. Hall to nominate a candidate for the Fort Augustus District in the place of T. A. McLean was representative and very largely attended. Two names were put in nomination before the delegates viz, Leonard Wood, Mount Herbert and S. C. Clarke, Mount Stewart. On a ballot being taken Mr. Wood received 83 votes to Mr. Clarke's 6 and Mr. Wood's nomination was made unanimous. He replied thanking the voters for the honor conferred and promising to do his best for the district.

Mr. Matheson moved yesterday in the Provincial Legislature the following resolution:—Resolved, That this House regrets that the estimates of expenditure recommended by His Honour the Lieutenant Governor will greatly exceed the estimated revenue of the current year and condemns the policy of the Government in failing to make revenue and expenditure meet. And further this House condemns the Government on the following grounds:

(1) That notwithstanding that the Act authorizing the imposition of succession duties was passed upon the express understanding that the moneys arising therefrom should constitute a special fund for the maintenance of the insane and poor; no such fund has been established and the said moneys have been used as ordinary revenue.

(2) That the Government though authorized by Statute to borrow \$175,000 only have borrowed money in excess of that sum in violation of the Statute and without giving the tenders thereof any security therefor.

(3) That the Government had failed to enforce the law intended to protect the stock-raters of this Province against importations of diseased cattle, have mismanaged the stock farm and sold therefrom stock at prices far below the market value by private sale contrary to law.

(4) That the Debenture Sinking Fund of this Province is in an unsatisfactory condition and in the case of \$35,000 of these debentures the Sinking Fund is growing less every year.

(5) That the law with respect to the public schools of this Province has been systematically violated and the school system of this Province has been greatly injured by the present Government.

(6) That the Public Works of this Province have been neglected and the moneys appropriated therefore by this House have been improvidently and wastefully expended. That the system of expending public money on public works by public competition has to a large extent been abandoned and in some cases the Officers of the Government are themselves contractors.

(7) That the Government is responsible for having introduced and passed in this House a Statute setting free candidates from responsibility for corrupt acts of their agents except in certain cases which had the effect of preventing the trial of election petitions then pending against members of the Government and their supporters in this House, and this House is of opinion that the said Statute should be repealed and a stringent election law enacted in its stead at the present session of this House.

(8) That the Public Accounts of this Province have been improperly kept and large sums owing by this Province at the close of the last fiscal year have been concealed and for several years past a most reprehensible practice has prevailed of paying out large sums of money for purposes never authorized by this House.

(9) That the Government have permitted the Public Moneys to be unlawfully taken by their associates in the Government and have entered into contracts with members of this House contrary to law, and the Government has refused to disclose the sums so paid and taken and to attempt at restitution has been made by the offending parties or sought by the Government.

DURING the last week in Halifax potatoes have gone up to 75 cents a bushel wholesale, and are now being retailed at 12 cents per half-peck, or 90 cents a bushel. One large dealer here received a letter from a Boston House offering 70 cents a bushel for all he could send.

The S. S. City of London came in yesterday morning from East River ports with upwards of 125 passengers, many of whom report the roads very heavy and the weather unfavorable for farming. The cargo consisted of 30 cases eggs, 15 hogs, 10 bbls oysters, 1 cow, 1 horse and sundry other consignments. She left for Crapaud at two this a.m. and leaves again this afternoon at three, returning about ten.

CONSIDERABLE excitement was created early yesterday morning on Kent Street west by the raiding of a house by a number of the police officers. When the officers forced their way into the house all was in darkness, but the sounds of revelry heard a few minutes before indicated that there were a number of occupants in the building. Lanterns were procured and the door again forced in. About a dozen young men were found in various parts of the house and driven out by the police. In the yard to the rear one secured an axe with which he threatened to do some damage but he was disarmed by an officer. In the melee glasses, bottles, etc. were flying around the heads of the police.

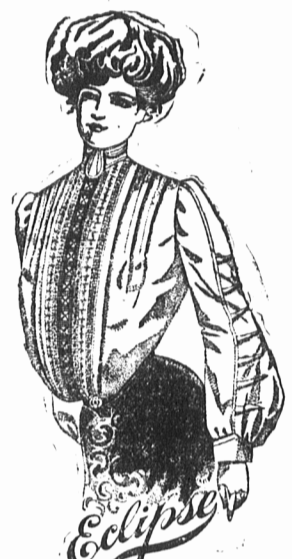

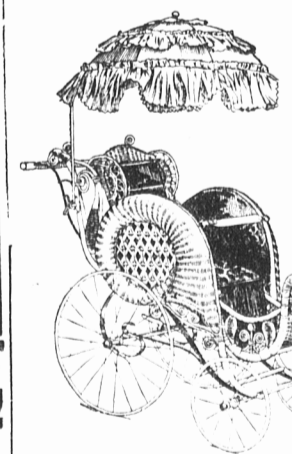
