## CARPENTER FALLS AT NEW THEATRE

ATTLEBORO, Sept. 28.—While engaged upon a high scaffold inside the new moving picture house on Band St., on Sept. 20th, Albert Young, a carpenter employed by McKinnon & Nicholson, lost his balance and fell to the floor, a distance of nearly 30 feet. He was severely bruised and shaken up, and his collar bone was broken.

Young had been working near the roof and swung from a small staging onto another one about six feet lower. He landed upon it safely, but swayed backwards, losing his balance and pitching head foremost towards the floor. Fortunately his body struck a ladder and turned in such a manner that he struck upon his left shoulder and back.

Harrison C. Swift and Albert Allen witnessed the fall and immediately sent for physicians, believing Young was seriously hurt. Dr. J. W. Battershall responded and took Young home in his automobile. An examination showed that Young had a fractured

### PROVINCIALIST TAKES CHARGE OF B.G. ORGAN

The Guardian is indebted to a friend in Montreal for the following clipping referring to a son of this province who has won fame in musical circles.

Messrs. Casavant Bros, the well-known organ builders, have just completed in the church of St. Vincent de Paul, corner of St. Catherine and Fullum Sts, the second largest organ in the city, the largest being in Notre Dame Church. The new organ is the most complicated 4th manual instrument yet turned out by this firm. It was inaugurated this week by Mr. Tremblay, the organist of the Basilica of Ottawa, and will be presided over by the first time at divine service to-morrow by Prof. F. F. Poirier, the newly-appointed organist, ex-organist of St. Patrick's church, and music teacher at the Montreal College.

Prof Poirier was born in 1882 at Prince Edward Island. Besides his musical education with Prof Dusseault, organist of Notre Dame Church, he completed his classical and philosophic course at the University of St Joseph, New Brunswick, and graduated as Bachelor of Arts there. He will give several recitals on the new organ during the course of the season.

### RE-OPENING OF THE SILVER FALLS METHODIST CHURCH.

ST. JOHN, Sept. 27.—The reopening of the Silver Falls Methodist church took place Sunday. At the morning service Rev G. M. ### CUTTER NOT CAPTURED BY MORO PIRATES.

MANILAT, Sept. 27.—Rumors in official despatches that the revenue cutter Sora has been captured by Moro pirates, were proven unfounded by the receipt today of news of the safe arrival of the cutter at Sandakan, north of Borneo. On board was J. L. Perrine, collector of the port of Balabac, who made the journey to purchase supplies. No word of an encounter with pirates was included in the news of the vessel's arrival.

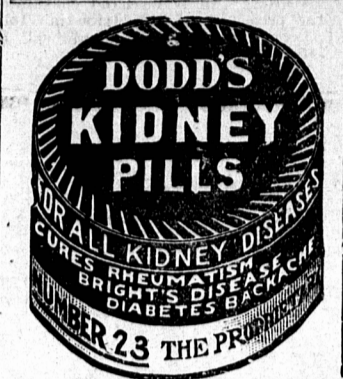
Coroner Berryman empanelled a jury, and an inquest was held. In their verdict the jury declared that Kelly's death was due to a mistake on the part of the winchman operating the winch at No. 1 hatch on the Orithia, and recommended that in future, when workmen were at work with their backs to the winchman another man should be engaged to give warning when the winch is operated.

Mrs Kelly in her action claims her husband's death was caused by negligence. It is believed that this is the first action brought in this province under the Workmen's Compensation Act.

### A WIDOW SUES STEAMSHIP LINE

ST. JOHN, N. B., Sept. 28.—Mrs Catherine Kelly, widow of Michael J. Kelly who was killed on the Donaldson line steamer Orithia on the night of Sept. 8, has decided to take action against the steamship company for damages for her husband's death, and has engaged John A. Barry to proceed for her. Mrs Kelly's action will be brought under the Workmen's Compensation Act, and she will ask for damages to the amount of \$1,500 the maximum allowed under the act.

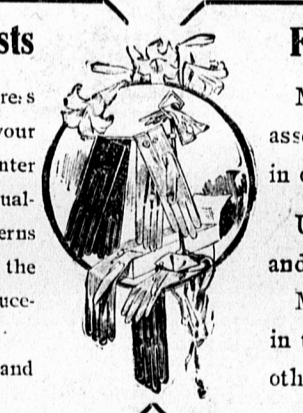

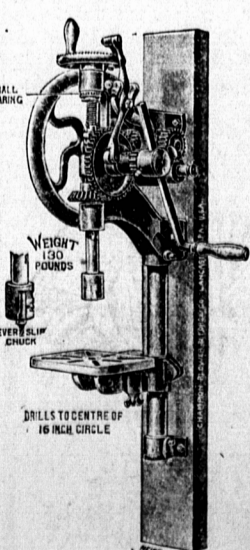
