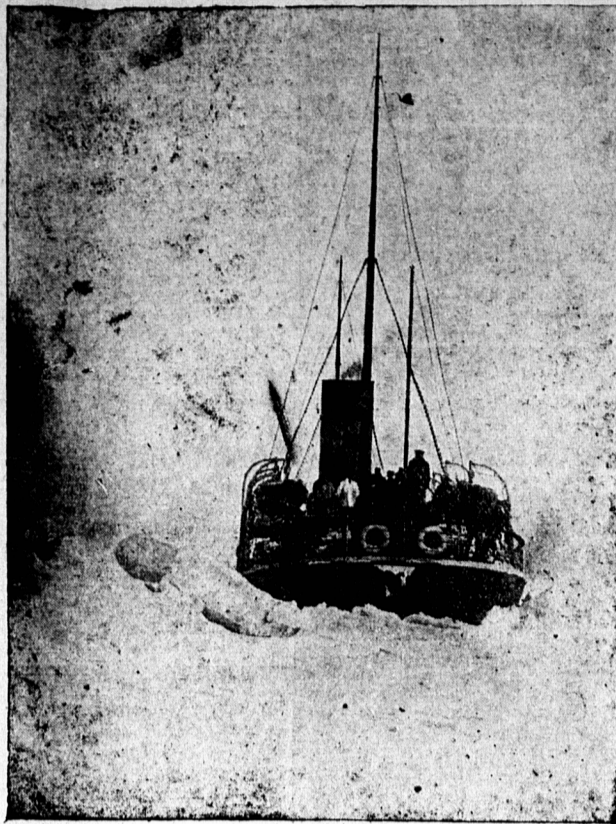

At 11 a. m. the Bishop celebrated, offering special prayers of dedication; he also preached an appropriate and eloquent sermon on the accessories of public worship as in unison with God. At this service the assistants were Rev D. Hunt and the rector. In the afternoon the Bishop proceeded to St Eleanor's and confirmed 15 persons. His address to the candidates and congregation was immensely practical and made a deep impression on his hearers. In the evening there was choral even song followed by the confirmation of 7 persons. The Bishop's sermon on the subject The Light of the World was most helpful and inspiring. On Monday morning service was held at 10 o'clock, when the Bishop spoke to the W. S. on the work of the organization. In the afternoon a very enjoyable at home was given to visitors, by the ladies of St Mary's Church, on H. J. Massy's beautiful grounds. In the evening service was held in the church at 8 o'clock. Canon Simpson was prevented from speaking by an attack of illness. The Rector publicly thanked the Rev R. G. Strathie and the Presbyterian congregation of Summerside, for their kindness in granting St Mary's people the use of their Hall for Divine Service, since the fire of 1906 which destroyed the English Church, Rectory and Guild Hall. 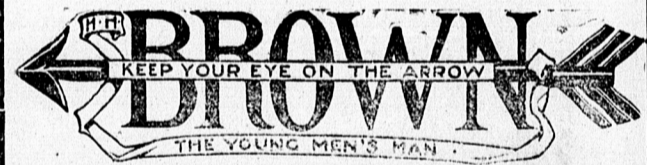

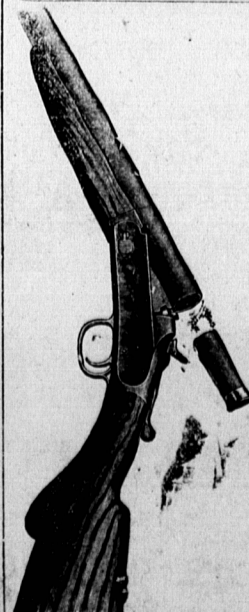
