SPEAKING ENGLISH DEFORMS THE MOUTH.

LONDON, Jan. 24.—Lord Ashbourne in a speech at a meeting of the Gaelic League in Fermoy, declared that speaking English continually deforms the mouth. He described Englishmen as having thin, prominent teeth and the general appearance of a mealy rabbit.

The German language, Lord Ashbourne said, was strong and vigorous. The English language was in a state of roteness and decay. John Bull's furr, he said, was behind him. He was insular and nothing would bring him in touch with the outside world.

H. R. MOLELLAN IS LIKELY TO BE NEXT WARDEN OF COUNCIL.

ST. JOHN, Jan. 24.—It is probable that the next warden of the Municipal Council will be Councillor H. R. Molellan. The election will take place at the annual meeting on Tuesday afternoon in the council chamber of the court house. Mr. Molellan has announced his intention of being a candidate and it now seems probable that he will have no opposing candidates. Councillors Bryant and Golding, both of Lancaster, have been mentioned as candidates but it was said today that neither of them will run. Thomas Carson, the retiring warden, will not be a candidate at this time.

PREACHER FROWNS ON MARRIAGE CONVENTION.

LONDON, Jan. 24.—Rev. W. H. G. Shapcott, chaplain of the prison at Great Scotland Yard, has created a great sensation by a sermon which he preached at Harrow in reference to the subject of marriage. Men and women were now allowed to marry whom they liked to the prejudice of their kind, he said.

"We must throw away our meek modesty, ridiculous sentiment, our foolish worship of the Baal of convention, and take the same trouble in arranging marriages and procuring the human race as we did in breeding horses. Under the present system we breed knaves and fools all over the place. It was time this matter was regulated and the breeding of frecks should not be allowed any more. A higher power should censor the human race and not permit them to become fathers and mothers unless they were fitted for their duties."

Dealing with the common use of profanity he said that profanity did not mean swearing. He had sworn often, but he did not call himself profane.

"A spoiled man often needs to raise a good swear. When a man feels deeply and has righteous indignation, there is forgiveness for him if occasionally a word overtoppies."

HAD HEAVIEST SNOW STORM IN YEARS

FREDERICTON, Jan. 24.—Fredericton had one of its heaviest snow storms in years Thursday, ten inches of snow having fallen according to the official measurements made at the Dominion Meteorological Station at the University of New Brunswick. The total snow fall here this winter to date is upwards of 26 inches and the reports received indicate that yesterday's storm was general throughout the province.

Lumbermen who had been complaining of there not being enough snow, are now fearful that the snow fall may be so heavy as to interfere with their operations.
