

**THURSDAY**  
**SUMMER HOME.**—Holland Cove, the popular summer resort is being rapidly prepared for holiday seekers. Among the buildings newly erected will be a five room house being built at the point beyond Holland Cove for the family of Colonel Inga. At least one other cottage is to be built by the company which will bring the total number on the Summer Resorts property up to thirty. Mr. George DeBois has had a cottage built this year at Ringwood Farm and Mr. Gerald Bremner also has a cottage at Ringwood nearing completion. Among the early tourists arriving are Rev. **SHEEP DIPPING.**—Mr. Leo McDonald has had excellent success in sheep dipping these last few days. On Monday and Tuesday he dipped upwards of five hundred and fifty sheep, and the prospect is that before this week is completed he will have pretty well on to 1,500 through the vat. He also reports an increased interest in sheep through the section through which he is travelling, due, no doubt, to the excellent prices of lamb and of wool and to the value of sheep as weed destroyers. Mr. McDonald uses every opportunity to explain to the public the provisions of the Act of the Sheep Breeders' Association, particularly in reference to the insuring of sheep. Grade sheep can be insured at one cent a piece and Pure Bred sheep at three cents each. The result is that nearly every owner of sheep through the districts that the dipping is being done, are insuring their sheep. Saturday Mr. McDonald will give a demonstration at the farmstead of Mr. P. C. Holm, DeSable.

**VOLUNTEER HONORED.**—A memorial event took place on Sunday afternoon 13th inst., at Abram's Village, when a large crowd from the village and surrounding districts, assembled in the Four House, to take part in a demonstration given in honor of Mr. Theophilus E. Arsenault, the volunteer who was home on a short visit. An eloquent address accompanied by a tangible gift was presented to Mr. Arsenault, after which several speeches of a complimentary nature were made. The meeting was presided over by Mr. Cyrus Gallant, who in a very eloquent discourse explained its purpose. Rev. Father Baudreault was present, and in his remarks gave some very good counsels to our brave boy. The Rev. Remarks were also made in connection with physical and military drill in school, and parents were cautioned to realize fully the importance of observing all celebration in connection with Empire; children must be taught the great lesson of Patriotism. **\*FISHING.**—Latest reports from the Magdalen Islands indicate that Herring, Lobsters and Cod are now plentiful. Mackerel have now appeared in Souris waters, while cod and herring are plentiful. About 4,000 lbs. of lobsters is the daily average at Souris factories while on the North Side the catches have run as high as 14,000 lbs., the average however being around 7,000 lbs.\*

**\*CAPT. HOLMES REINSTATED.**—Capt. Holmes, who had his master's certificate taken from him for a time on account of the Morwena coming into collision with the Dartmouth ferry boat some months ago, has had it returned by the Minister of Marine. The Dominion Coal Co., which owned the Morwena known widely in shipping circles in Charlottetown, employed the captain in a minor capacity, and he was on board the same steamer when it was torpedoed by a German submarine later on off the coast of Scotland. In view of Capt. Holmes' conduct at this time, the Canadian Minister of Marine has deemed it advisable to hasten the time of giving back to the captain his master's certificate.

**ASHORE IN FOG.**—The chartered Cunard liner, Cheltonian, which was recently damaged by running ashore in a fog on Prince Edward Island, has been temporarily repaired at Sydney and arrived at Halifax late Monday night. She will discharge part of her cargo there and enter the dry dock as soon as the Esington vacates it. S. M. Brookfield has the contract to repair the Cheltonian, says a Halifax paper.

**KEROCENE FOR GASOLENE.**—Mr. T. B. Mothersill, well known in Charlottetown, where he resided for some time, and known also throughout the world in connection with the Mothersill sea sick remedies, is again associated with an enterprise which promises both fame and fortune. In collaboration with several Americans he has discovered a method by which keroce oil can be substituted for gasole as a motive power. Experiments tried in automobile tests have demonstrated the practicability of the discovery and it now remains only to manufacture this new fuel in sufficient quantities to meet the demand. In a private letter to a Charlottetown citizen, it is learned that a Ford auto recently made a journey of 140 miles at the rate of 23 miles an hour, with three and a half gallons keroce. The saving effected by the new device is estimated at 75 per cent. His many friends in Charlottetown will watch with much interest the development of this new power.

**MARINE INQUIRIES.**—Captain Demers, Dominion Wreck Commissioner, was expected to arrive in the city Tuesday night says a Halifax exchange, and will open the inquiry into the causes of and circumstances leading up to the stranding near Chebucto Head on the morning of Tuesday, June 8th, of the plant liner A. W. Perry. The inquiry will be conducted in the Customs House Building. Early next week Captain Demers will hold here the inquiry into the affair of the steamer Cheltonian which went ashore on the Newfoundland coast and was beached at North Sydney and later brought to Halifax to go into the dry dock.

**AGRICULTURAL MEETING.**—Prof. Theodore Ross addressed an agricultural meeting yesterday at Lake Verde. Mr. Walter Brown was chairman. The subject discussed was the care of cattle, particularly bulls, and the growing crops. At the conclusion of the meeting a Live Stock Breeders' Association was formed, and application will be made at once to the Live Stock Branch for some rams. **OF LOCAL INTEREST.**—The Calgary News Telegram of the 7th June contains the following:—Pte.
