WAR MUNITIONS SEIZED ON CLYDE LINE STEAMER

NEW YORK, Dec. 1. (Special)—A dozen United States Custom House inspectors yesterday went on board the Seminole, of the Clyde line, which lay at pier No. 34, Atlantic Basin, Brooklyn, and without ceremony brushed past the officers and crew, and proceeded to search the ship. In a brief period of time they found 10,000 rounds of rifle and revolver ammunition and a score or so of revolvers which did not appear on the manifest of the vessel.

Captain Judson T. Carey, of the Seminole, is said not to have been aboard his vessel when the search was made. His subordinates declared that it did not surprise them when the customs inspectors discovered the arms and ammunition. The Seminole will steam this afternoon for San Domingo and other ports.

The seizure was made on orders from General Nelson H. Henry, Surveyor of the Port, who had received word that there were arms aboard the vessel and sent A. O. Hokensea, a customs inspector, to ascertain if the information was true. It did not take Hokensea and his men long, for the person who had told them that munitions of war were concealed aboard the Seminole also indicated to the customs officials the exact places where the arms and cartridges could be found.

Hokensea and the other men said little when they went aboard the Seminole. Their mere presence told the tale to the surprised officers and crew. Hokensea first went to the boilers of the donkey engine, where several thousand rounds of ammunition were discovered. Not long afterward he detailed four men to find out if anything was hidden in the coal bunkers under the coal. There was. This was a harder job, but soon the customs men discovered more cartridges and revolvers.

Officers of the ship declared their innocence in the matter and Hokensea next went down to the forecastle. There each bunk was searched, and one of them was found to have a double bottom. In this affair, which had been rigged up by a fireman, four revolvers and several rounds of cartridges were discovered.

NEW ANAESTHESIA WITHOUT DRUGS

HARTFORD, CONN., Dec. 1. (Special)—Dr. William H. Fitzgerald, an ear and throat specialist of this city who formerly had offices in New York, today demonstrated a new local anaesthetic at St. Francis Hospital in the presence of thirty Connecticut physicians. The unanimous opinion was expressed that the discovery probably would revolutionize present methods of surgery.

Dr. Fitzgerald operated upon several patients, and in no case did he use drugs, gas or cocaine. He applied a pressure to the nerves through the nose or throat, acting, as he explained, on the well known fact that there are certain especially sensitive nerve zones, pressure upon which instantly will stop pain. In one case he anesthetized the hand of a woman so that pins were thrust into the flesh without giving the slightest pain.

In another case a foot was anaesthetized and fifteen incisions made. Two teeth were painlessly extracted. In still another case, after producing an anaesthetized condition, the physician punctured an ear drum without any sensation of pain. The puncturing of an ear drum is regarded as one of the most painful of operations.

Another test was even more startling. The physician removed a foreign substance from the patient's eye and then drew a scalpel lightly across the eyeball, the patient never wincing.

This demonstration by Dr. Fitzgerald was a sequel to one he gave at the hospital two weeks ago, in which he showed the preliminary steps to the use of the methods. In the preliminary clinic the patients were shown to be able to trace the sensations of glow or a feeling of lightness. By pressures in the throat the physician produced sensations in various parts of the body, in the back or to the extremities, for instance, and demonstrated that acute pain in any section of the body can be relieved quickly by mere pressure.

There are several advantages to be gained from the use of reflex anaesthesia as demonstrated. In the first place the use of dangerous anaesthetics like ether is avoided. In spite of the general use of other its administration is still accompanied by gravest danger except in the hands of an expert.

The Hon. 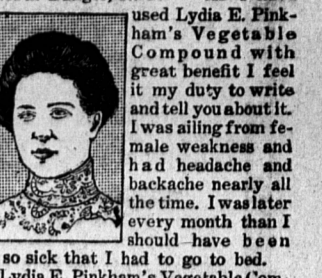
