Run 20-30 yards. Reach top speed last 5 yards. Make last stride short. Practice 'run-up' repeatedly. Try to run in same spots each time.

After short final stride, 'kick-off' by driving hard with body leaning slightly forward. Crouch slightly, drive free leg up and in front of you.

**HITCH KICK**  
To increase jumping distance use 'hitch kick' while in air. This is accomplished by pulling up and 'take-off' until landing. Practice and you will improve!
