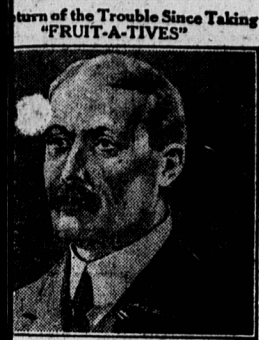

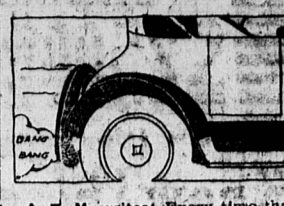
STARTING SUGGESTIONS

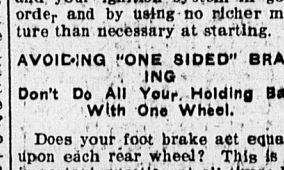

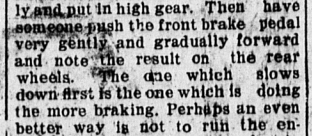
GENERATOR WORKS ONLY WHEN WARM



A. K. R. writes: My generator will not deliver charging current, regularly, until it is warmed up and, when the engine cools down it again gives trouble. Putting a few

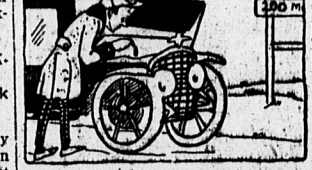
drops of kerosene on the commutator will cause it to generate regularly for a few hundred miles, when the trouble reappears. Can you tell me what is wrong?

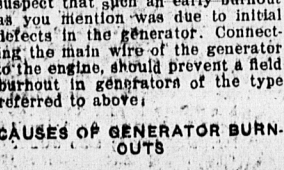

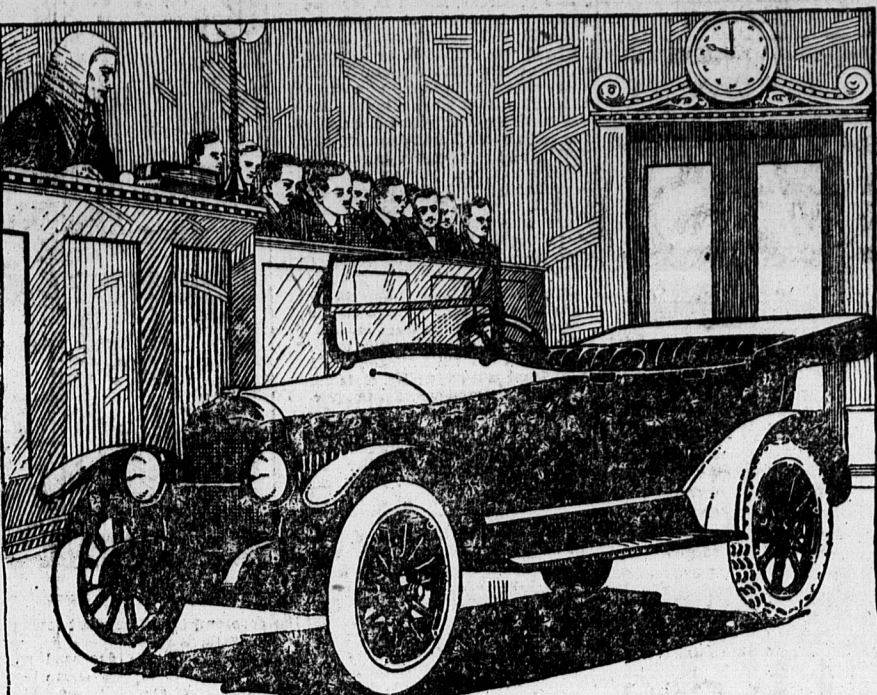

USE OF GRAPHITE GREASE

W. asks: Is it a good idea to use graphite grease in filling the cups on the ends of the springs?

HOW TO REMOVE STAINS.

To remove the white stain caused by water or other liquids rub well with kerosene. If this does not have perfect results rub with mixture of oil (either sweet or linseed) and turpentine in the proportion of two parts of oil to one of turpentine.

ink stains on wood surfaces may be removed by a weak solution of oxalic acid. Allow to stand on the stain for a short time; repeat if necessary.

Grease stains when large and fresh, may be removed by covering with dry material as flour, corn starch or cornmeal, or merely by washing with warm water.

For dark spots or discolorations caused by lodged varnish or oil, remove by rubbing with sandpaper and have the spot refinished. When refinishing any piece of furniture at home, first remove all of the old finish by the use of a strong solution of ammonia or washing soda, or Gille's lye, which dissolves the varnish or paint, followed by scraping and another washing.
