FIGHT IN NEW BRUNSWICK OVER PROPOSED RESTRAINTS

Against Sending Liquor by Express Into Scott Act Counties—Temperance and Liquor Delegations Heard Before the Government—Liquor Men's Counsel Claim that Proposed Legislation is Ultra Vires—How it Would Affect the Trade.

FREDERICTON, N. B., Mar. 6.—(Special)—Two delegations representing liquor sellers and the temperance people appeared before the Local Government this morning regarding the carrying of liquor into Scott Act Counties by express companies.

MOBILE, Ala., March 5.—A long distance message to the item from J. D. Breaux, service man of the Cumberland Telephone Co. at Meridian, Miss. gives complete details of the cyclone that struck Meridian as follows:

"During a heavy rain at 6.30 o'clock a storm cloud developed in the south and moved quickly over the city, striking Front Street, the business center with full force. The wind was probably blowing 75 miles an hour. The cyclone passed over in about two minutes and during that period three or four whole squares were devastated. A conservative estimate places the number of buildings blown down at between 30 and 40.
