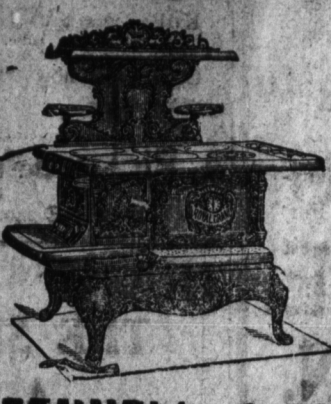

SITUATION IN MADRID SERIOUS

Police Charged Crowds, Many Injured, Among Them Bishop of Madrid

MADRID, Dec. 4.—The situation here, resulting from the extraordinary Cabinet crisis, is regarded as grave. The population is greatly excited and an intolerant animosity is maintained throughout the night. The police were compelled to charge the crowds and numbers of people were injured. Among the latter was the Grand Vicar Bishop of Madrid, who was hit by a stone.
King Alfonso desires the Liberals to continue in power, but he evidently believes that Spafia is not ready for the violent anti-clerical programme of the extremists. A middle course, however, is almost impossible, owing to the personal ambitions and jealousies of the leaders of the Radical and Moderate groups, which give clerical opportunities to renew their pressure on the King.
About two thousand women of the aristocracy, headed by the Duchess De Balen, have petitioned the King against the law of associations.
King Alfonso has approved of a new ministry under the Premiership of the Marquis De Armiijo in which General Weyer resumes his old post of Minister for War.

ROYALTY VISIT IRON WORKS

King and Queen Inspect The Mammoth Industry at Norfolk.

LONDON, Eng., Dec. 5.—The King and Queen recently visited the Thorburn Ironworks, Norfolk, where her Majesty took part in making an iron gate.
In the designing office at the works their Majesties inspected many of the original drawings and designs, including one of a gate which is being made for the King to be erected at Sandringham.
The royal party then proceeded to the works, where the iron is beaten into elaborate devices. There Queen Alexandra took a hammer from one of the workmen, and, with the request, "If I may have a hand in making one of our gates," hammered away at a piece of iron with wonderful energy.

A BIG DEAL IN RUBBER TRADE IS ANNOUNCED
Holding Company Granted to Take In Three Prosperous Canadian Concerns
THE CAPITAL IS \$5,000,000

Canadian Rubber Co., Granby Rubber Co. and Maple Leaf Rubber Co. are in the Deal.
One of the biggest industrial enterprises in Canada has just been created. The news came out on the Stock Exchange to-day that the Canadian Rubber Co., the Granby Rubber Co., and the Maple Leaf Rubber Co., had been taken over by the Canadian Consolidated Rubber Co., Ltd., with a capitalization of \$5,000,000 stock and \$2,000,000 40-year, 6 per cent. gold bonds.
It is understood that Mr. S. H. C. Miner, the head of the Granby Company, will be president of the new concern, while Mr. G. W. Stephens, M. L. A., who has recently directed the Canadian Rubber Co., will be vice-president.
Big things seem to be stirring in the rubber world these days for the news of the giant Canadian deal comes on the heels of the announcement that the King of Belgium, who controls the enormous rubber areas of the Congo, has sold immense tracts there to prominent United States capitalists, who are at the head of the General Rubber Goods Company of the United States.
This concern, it is understood, buys the raw material for the companies that are now under the wing of the Canadian Consolidated.
The news also came out not long ago that the Continental Rubber Co. of the United States, capital \$50,000,000, is exploiting newly discovered rubber bearing areas in Mexico, while British interests are also alive to their opportunities and are sending vast amounts of capital to encourage the cultivation of rubber in India and Ceylon.
In fact, there seems to be a world wide boom in the rubber industry, not only in Canada, but everywhere else the factories, owing to the many new uses to which rubber products are being put, find it difficult to keep up with the demand.
In the last few years, two years in fact, the Canadian Rubber Co. has come along with a rush.
A few months ago the financial world was started by the announcement that a group of progressive young men had seen the vast possibilities of the trade and had bought a controlling interest in the Canadian Rubber Co.
The business kept steadily increasing in volume and it followed a comparatively short time that the Canadian and Granby concerns joined hands.
A few weeks ago the campaign of conquest was still on and the progressive Maple Leaf Co. of Port Dalhousie, Ont., was brought into the fold.
The creation of a big holding company for the three concerns means the final step in a campaign that has already practically revolutionized the Canadian rubber trade.
The three concerns are showing net earnings of over \$400,000 yearly and the appearance of the stock and bonds of Canadian Consolidated is awaited with no little interest by the brokers and their clients.
The success of the deal is being handled by the Bank of Toronto and The Royal Trust Co.
It was said to-day that Mr. D. Lorne McGibbon will be second vice-president and general manager of the Canadian Consolidated.

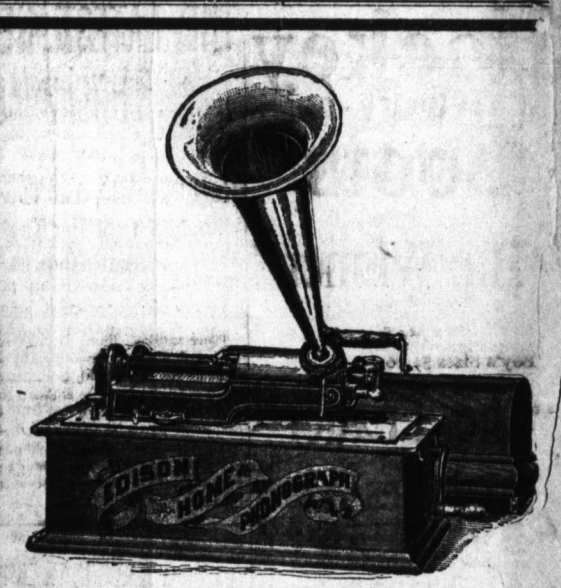
