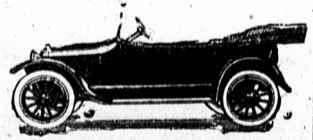

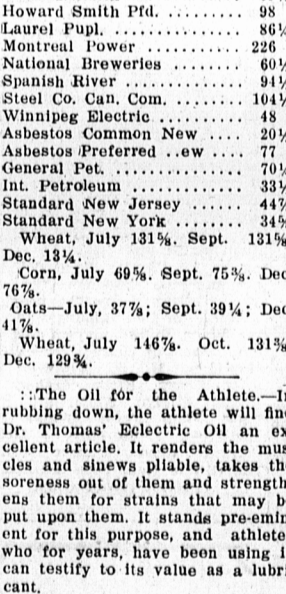
In Memoriam

MRS. MARY MACQUARRIE
 The death occurred at her residence, Gerald Street at 7 o'clock yesterday morning of Mary MacQuarrie, widow of the late John MacQuarrie.
 Mrs. MacQuarrie was seized with a stroke of paralysis on Sunday morning just as she was preparing to leave to attend the sacramental services in the Church of Scotland at Lot 48. She apparently rallied from the stroke and seemed to be improving Monday, but in the evening she took a turn for the worse, and gradually sank until the end came.
 She was born at Rice Point, West River, on March 28th, 1843, and had therefore passed her 83rd year. She was the daughter of the late Donald MacEachern and Mary Campbell, her parents having emigrated from Scotland to Prince Edward Island.
 After her marriage she resided at Nine Mile Creek for many years until the death of her husband in 1917, when she removed to Charlottetown with her daughter, Miss Jennie.
 Mrs. MacQuarrie up to her last illness had generally enjoyed excellent health, and was remarkably active for one of her advanced years. She was a member of the Church of Scotland, and always took a deep interest in church work. She was a splendid type of a Christian woman, and possessed those qualities of mind and heart which endeared her to all who knew her.
 There are left to cherish her memory, three daughters, Belle, wife of Mr. James J. Taylor, St. Peter's Island; Louise, wife of Mr. A. Bonnell, Bursar of Falconwood Infirmary, and Miss Jennie at home; also one step-son, Neil MacEachern of Nine Mile Creek, one step-daughter, Mrs. Elizabeth Bell, Providence, Rhode Island, and four brothers, John MacEachern, Rhode Island; Daniel MacEachern, New York; James and Neil MacEachern of Rice Point in this province.
 The funeral will leave her late residence on Thursday, July 1st at 1 p. m. to the People's Church,
